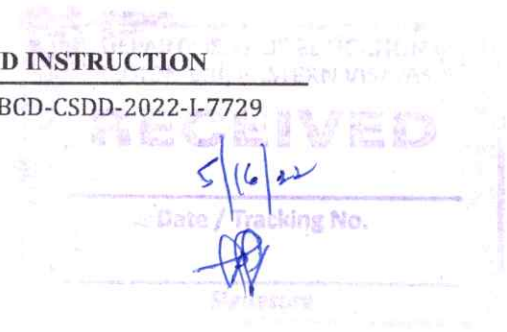

The Philippine Space Agency (PhilSA), the country's agency that addresses national issues and activities related to space science and technology applications, announces the call for proposals for the **Asian Try Zero-G**. The Try Zero-G is one of the activities in the Asian Beneficial Collaboration through Kibo Utilization (Kibo-ABC Program) which is in coordination with the Japan Aerospace Agency (JAXA). The program aims to promote the utilization and share the value of the Japanese Experiment Module "Kibo" on the International Space Station (ISS) by conducting selected experiments from the Asia Pacific region.

Junior and Senior High School learners are encouraged to submit proposal. Those whose proposal will be selected will have a chance to work in person or remotely with JAXA scientists and engineers in planning for the conduct of their experiments in space. PhilSA will accept and review proposals until May 20, 2022. Junior and Senior High school learners under 18 years old shall be in Category 1.

PhilSA will select up to three (3) proposals that will be sent to JAXA who will choose the best proposal among participating Kibo-ABC member countries.
