- d. Master's Research Grants

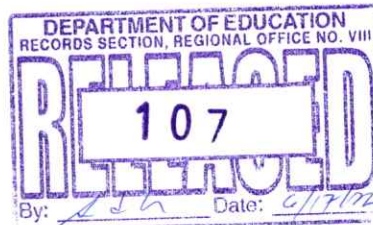
The **deadline** for submission of application is **June 30, 2022**.

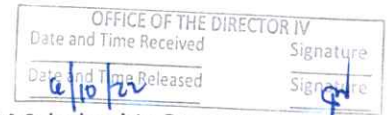
