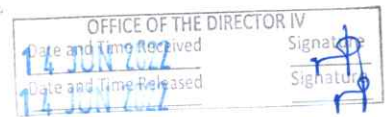

Subject : TRAINING OF ALS TEACHERS IN PILOT SCHOOLS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED MELCs-BASED ALS SHS CURRICULUM

Date : June 7, 2022

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct the Training of Alternative Learning System (ALS) Teachers in Pilot Schools on the Implementation of the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs)-Based ALS Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum on July 25-30, 2022 (inclusive of travel time) in Region XI, Davao City (exact venue will be announced in a separate issuance).

This activity aims to:

1. Develop deep understanding, familiarization, and appreciation of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum among ALS Teachers;
2. Train the ALS Teachers of four (4) pilot schools from Regions V & XI on the delivery and contextualization process of learning competencies in ALS context; and
3. Enable the teacher-participants to prepare an implementation plan of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum in their respective schools.

Particular attention is invited to Attachment No.1 for the List of Participants and Attachment No. 2 for the Training Matrix. The listed participants are required to bring their own laptops and a copy of the MELCs of their assigned core or applied subjects during the training.

The first meal to be served will be breakfast on July 25, 2022, and the last meal will be breakfast on July 30, 2022.

The participants are also requested to comply with all COVID-19 Alert Level System protocols set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules

and/or policies.

Transportation expenses, board and lodging, other expenses for supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses incurred for this activity shall be charged against the 2022 FLO-ALS Continuing Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. **Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants will be downloaded directly to respective Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and shall be paid in full upon submission of the required travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.**

In case that the downloaded funds is not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, local funds shall be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.
