

Greetings from the Civil Service Commission!

We are pleased to inform you that the following individuals have been featured in the online segments entitled Honor Awards Program (HAP) Story and Lingkod Bayan Diaries (LBD):

- Ms. Michelle D. Rubio, Master Teacher II, Calao Elementary School, Department of Education-Division of Sorsogon, Prieto-Diaz, Sorsogon, 2019 Dangal ng Bayan; and
- PCPT Rhia B. Sotomil (Ret), Pavia Municipal Police Station, Philippine National Police Regional Office VI, Pavia, Iloilo, 2014 Dangal ng Bayan

Said online segments present the anthology of civil servants' stories that aim to inspire other kawani through short videos and interviews of public service exemplars which are available in the Philippine Civil Service Facebook page and Youtube channel.

Ms. Rubio was recognized in the annual Search for Outstanding Government Workers for her pioneering initiatives in making learning interesting. Her Classhome and Reading Car have developed comprehensive reading skills while the Dugtong Buhay supported the basic needs of indigent students encouraging them to come to school even without baon and school materials. Her Resort for Learning is a small nook transformed into an outdoor "mini-resort" to reach out to non-readers; similar nooks have been put up not only in 19 schools in Prieto Diaz but also in schools in Gubat and Irosin in Sorsogon, and the Ricardo P. Cruz, Sr. Elementary School in Taguig City. Ms. Rubio also actively engaged mothers, assigning them to help create reading hubs where kids can grow to love learning.

Similarly, retired PCPT Sotomil was recognized for putting the interest of the public above her own. Despite being diagnosed with lupus, she continued to excel in her performance as a police officer, focusing on issues such as violence against women and their children, and health advocacy. Transforming her weakness into strength, she championed women and children's rights, as well as health and wellness thus empowering her community.
