June 21, 2022

Objective: To discuss the different issues and concerns regarding the unification of Tacloban City Night High School and Cirilo Roy Montejo Night High School

The meeting started at around 9:30 am at the hall of Cirilo Roy Montejo Night High School. Mrs. Andree U Turija was the emcee of the activity. It was opened with a prayer led by Ms. Jocelyn G. Papiona and followed by the singing of the Philippine National Anthem conducted by Bernadette R. Catilogo. Afterwards, the checking of attendance per school and from the SDO Team.

After the checking of attendance, the meeting proper was led by Sir Jade Calleja. He has discussed on the following:

- ✓ Agenda of the meeting:
 - Reasons on the unification of two schools (TCNiHS and CRMNiHS)
 - Technical Assistance on the Unification Process
- ✓ Sir Jade has presented what transpired during the Coordination Meeting with the Regional Team where he presented the problems of the two schools.

- TCNiHS is situated nearby a river and has no space for buildings
- CRMNiHS is facing a problem on the decrease of enrolment and so with the other night high schools
- ✓ Closing of SJNiHS, ANiHS, CRMNiHS and TCNiHS and put it in One site called as the "NEW TACLOBAN CITY NIGHT HIGH SCHOOL" at the Old City Division where the Cirilo Roy Montejo Night High School is located.
- ✓ Plans for the "New TCNiHS, Center for Alternative Delivery Learning)
 - *Construction of a new building at the right side of the campus
 - * The school will be under ALS EPS Sir Ranulfo Baay, to monitor its implementation.
- ✓ ALS personnel will be transferring to the new TCNiHS campus, once the repair of the room at the back of the main building will be finished.
- ✓ The teachers will be grouped by Department based on the Delivery Mode to be implemented.
 - * The delivery modes could be NIGHT CLASSES (F2F), MODULAR PRINT, ONLINE/BLENDED, DISTANCE/OPEN LEARNING EDUCATION
 - * The only school to implement MODULAR Print next School Year
 - *The lone Night High School in the city to cater all the working students
- ✓ CRMNiHS will be closed officially after July 2, 2022.
- ✓ Tacloban City Night High School will be operational at the old school site after July 2 to July 30 to give time for transfer of all the facilities to the new TCNiHS campus.
- ✓ It was emphasized by Sir Jade not to bring chairs and dilapidated materials.
- ✓ 1 week before July 30, a formal turn-over of all materials to LNHS must be properly documented, same with all facilities to be brought to the new Tacloban City Night High School campus will also be properly documented.
- ✓ By August 2022 during the opening of classes, the school will be called as Tacloban City Night High School, with school ID of 303668, and the closure of 3 night high schools(SanJose Night, Cirilo Night and Anibong Night High Schools)
- ✓ Inform the current learners of Tacloban City Night High School, G7-G9 about the new location of the school.
- ✓ Grade 7 entrants will be the subject of a 5-year night high school curriculum
- ✓ Currently enrolled Grades 7-9 students will NOT be covered by the 5-year curriculum and labeled as continuing students.
- ✓ Strict implementation of the minimum requirements and qualifications of students who will enrol as Grade 7.
- ✓ The 2 School Heads will help one another in crafting a School Program based on the modality to be implemented.
- ✓ **Based from queries and clarifications raised by the teachers during the Open Forum, the following are the highlights:**
 - *All teachers in CRMNiHS will be absorbed by the New Tacloban City Night High School to be included in the PSIPOP
 - *Continuing Learners will have a separate School Program
 - *Do not enrol learners who are not working students and those without valid reason/s to enrol in the night classes
 - * Assess the condition of the learner and suggest a modality that is suited to his

case

- * For Supply Matters (what to bring and not) please ask Jeanette Lagunzad
- * In terms of Finances, salaries of the personnel to be included in the PSIPOP maybe implemented by January 2023 while the PRU will request sir Rodel Naval to continue the release of MOOE for both schools. The MOOE of both schools will be combined to continue its operation.
- * The school must hang tarpaulins in conspicuous places around the city for advocacy of the lone night high school with new school site.
- * Ma'am Benitez from Tacloban City Night High School asked where to conduct the Enrichment classes. It was clarified by Sir Jade that enrichment classes will be conducted at the new Tacloban City Night High School campus.
- * The two schools will create transition committees.
- * All decisions will be for the sake of the learners.
- * Both parties, including the school heads and teachers agreed the unification of the two schools.

* The Planning Unit will make a Division Memorandum address to the school heads for the unification of Tacloban City Night High School and Cirilo Roy Montejo Night High School.

After all the ideas and concerns were discussed the session ended at 11:30 AM.

1. Presentation of the closing of the operations of Anibong Night High School and San Jose Night High School effective S.Y. 2022-2023;
2. The establishment of Anibong National High School;
3. Other pertinent issues and concerns relative to the transition and turn-over processes;

The meeting was called to order at 1:15 p.m. and was presided by Mr. Jade B. Calleja, Division Senior Education Program Specialist (Planning and Research Unit) and was attended with 100% attendance from the personnel of Anibong Night High School and San Jose Night High School and personnel from the Division – School Governance and Operations (SGOD), Angelo Alcaraz - Planning Officer III, Roger D. Dagale- EPS II, Engr. Rafael S. Lanza – Engineer III and Manolito C. Bolpa – EPS (M&E).

Mr. Calleja announced the closure of the two night high schools in Tacloban City – Anibong Night High School and San Jose Night High School – effective July 2, 2022 in the LIS (Learner's Information System). The said schools will no longer be operational for School Year 2022-2023. However, the teachers from the two schools will still continue to work especially on the yearend reports. A new school will be opened in Anibong, the Anibong National High School with a new school ID as the Regional Office did not permit the conversion of Anibong Night High School to Anibong National High School. Thus, the establishment of the new school with a new school ID using the same school location, existing school buildings and other facilities of Anibong Night High School. The personnel from both Anibong Night and San Jose Night will be retained in the school with Mr. Danilo S. Quejada as the school head. Mrs. Praxedes C. Balberia, school head of San Jose Night HS will later be reassigned to another school. Priority of teacher retention will be given to the Anibong Night High School teachers depending on the number of teachers needed for the establishment of the new school. However, all teachers from both schools are free to choose whether they will continue to work in the new school or request for reassignment in another school nearer their areas of residence.

Starting July 2, 2022, the San Jose Night High School will officially report to Anibong bringing with them the documents and papers especially all student records. The school head was advised to craft a new school program, room assignment and other ancillary assignments with teachers from both Night High Schools.

Mr. Roger D. Dagale, Division Education Program Specialist II (School Management Monitoring and Evaluation), added some announcement on the documents to be complied and set the deadline for submission to the Division Office before June 30, 2022. He announced that Anibong National High School will just operate as an extension school of another school for School Year 2022-2023 as the approval and release of permit/legal document bearing the name of Anibong National High School is scheduled to be released in February 2023. Technically, Anibong National High School will officially operate as an independent school starting School Year 2023-2024.


Mr. Jade Calleja, suggested that the Division Brigada Kick-Off 2022 be done in the new school – the Anibong National High School. Thus, he asked the two school heads from the two night high schools to utilize the school budget for July for the improvement and beautification of the new school. He suggested for flyers, brochures, big tarpaulins to be printed and be posted in all strategic areas of the city especially its neighboring barangays/catchment areas.

Mr. Danilo S. Quejada, the school head of Anibong Night High School requested all the teachers from the two night high schools to stay after the coordination meeting for another meeting regarding the committee composition for the preparation of documents for the establishment of the new school and for the Brigada Eskwela preparation.

Clarifications, suggestions and comments were asked from the body. Request for reassignment was clarified for the teachers who will opt to be reassigned in another school. Mr. Calleja advised to talk to them personally and make a letter of intent.

The Meeting adjourned at 2:55 p.m.
