CONCEPT NOTE

1. Background

UNESCO supports the Philippine Government through the Department of Education in its Alternative Learning System (ALS) Programme with the implementation of the "Better Life for Out-of-School Girls to Fight Poverty and Injustice in the Philippines" Project with the overall goal of improving quality of life for girls living in poverty particularly supporting out-of-school girls registered in ALS for their further education opportunities or future job chances. The project is envisioned to contribute in the attainment of Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) in the Philippines, particularly SDG 4 with the generous financial assistance of the Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA).

One key component of the Project is the establishment of the Girls Education Centre (GEC) located inside the compound of DepEd Regional Office VIII-Eastern Visayas, Government Centre, Brgy. Candahug, Palo, Leyte. This GEC is expected to be a one-stop educational hub where out-of-school girl-learners will be able to avail holistic support and opportunities to improve their lives through continuing learning and lifeskills training under ALS programme targeting ALS learners of Tacloban City and its vicinity including Palo in Leyte as the project's pilot areas.

In April 2021, the construction of the Girls Education Centre has commenced with the official ground-breaking ceremony and thereafter actual construction and is currently on-going. A slight delay was encountered in the construction due to the revision of the foundational structure of the building as a response to the significant challenge of a weak soil condition at the rear side of the GEC building site from the result of the joint-sectional survey conducted of the site. With the final revision of the foundational structural design completed, the construction activities resumed in October 2021.

Under the contract of VistaGreen, the engaged building contractor for the GEC, a monitoring and technical evaluation of the progress of the construction of the GEC building was undertaken to determine and confirm the 25% actual physical accomplishment of the construction on 17 March 2022. The second technical evaluation is planned for the month of July 2022 to further confirm and determine the 50% accomplishment of the physical construction of the building. Together with UNESCO, the Department of Education through the Education Facilities Division's team and KOICA, a monitoring and technical evaluation of the progress of the on-going construction will be carried out again. This task will involve field visit to the construction site and undertake actual physical check of the progress to be followed by a review and evaluation meeting to discuss the result and progress of the on-going construction work.

2. Objectives

The technical evaluation and review meeting aims to:

Check the progress of the on-going construction and determine the 50% level of the physical accomplishment
of the building based on the construction workplan and schedule of the Contractor through field visit inspection
and evaluation;

- Specify and indicate observations, technical points based on quality of work following the quality assurance measures and recommendations formed and developed from the field inspection and visit of the technical experts;
- 3) Discuss the result of the field visit monitoring and progress check by the team involved and develop specific agreements in terms of carrying out recommended steps to be undertaken towards the completion of the physical building.

3. Outcomes

The expected outcomes from the meeting are:

- 1) Levelling off of understanding on the actual physical accomplishment of the construction of the GEC building with clear field/ground understanding of the situation in the construction site;
- 2) Monitoring the actual physical accomplishments against the expected deliverables of the contractor based on agreed timelines;
- 3) Verifying and certifying the completion of 50% accomplishment of the physical construction of the GEC building;
- 4) Addressing issues and challenges encountered by the contractor in the on-going construction activities as part of the review and evaluation of the progress.
