1. The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) in collaboration with the Southeast Asian Minister of Education, Organization, Innovation, and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) implemented Batch 1 of professional development programs for teachers and school leaders last February to June 2022.
2. Out of 5025 scholars, **583 received a deficient rating** for their courses. As stated in DM 082 s. 2020, and in the scholar's NEAP PDP Contract, scholars are expected to *maintain the academic standards and other course requirements set for by the program*. Otherwise, scholars need to *refund in full to DepEd such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental to having attended the program or course, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions*.
3. NEAP and SEAMEO INNOTECH will provide a second opportunity for the listed scholars with deficient ratings (Enclosure 1) to complete their requirements. To ensure the privacy of data, regions are requested to **individually notify** the concerned scholars.
4. Relative to this, scholars need to resubmit their requirements per course via the resubmission links provided (Enclosure 2) **on or before October 30, 2022**. SEAMEO INNOTECH support staff will also send an email to the scholars for the complete instructions.
