- This Office, through the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD), announces the Call for Submission of Research Summary for the 2022 Eastern Visayas Basic Education Research Conference (EVBERC) on September 28-30, 2022 in Tacloban City with the theme, *"Research in the New Normal: The Future of Education Beyond COVID-19."*
- Completed Action Research and Basic Research in education within the scope of the Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA) thematic areas shall be regarded as entries. Submission of Thesis and Dissertations are also encouraged for the purpose of disseminating results. However, researches that were previously presented in DepEd conferences shall no longer be considered.
- Interested authors shall submit an electronic copy of the Research Paper Summary in Microsoft Word format on or before **September 9, 2022**, strictly observing the prescribed format for the manuscript by uploading it through the link: [bit.ly/3AJpW8P](https://bit.ly/3AJpW8P). The guidelines for the submission of manuscripts and format for the research summary are enclosed herewith for reference. Qualified entries shall be notified through a separate memorandum.
- The following Members of the Regional Research Secretariat and Technical Working Committee shall conduct the Online Pre-Screening of the submitted Research Papers on September 12-14, 2022.

**GUIDELINES ON THE SUBMISSION OF RESEARCH SUMMARY FOR THE  
2022 EASTERN VISAYAS BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCH COFERENCE (EVBERC)**

September 28-30, 2022 | Tacloban City

1. The research conference shall focus on showcasing the studies conducted at the school, district, division, or regional level that identify and address problems related to teaching and learning, child protection, human resource, governance of basic education, disaster risk reduction and management, inclusive education, and gender and development.
2. These studies shall include Action Researches, Basic Researches, Theses, and Dissertations in education within the scope of the Basic Education Research Agenda (BERA) thematic areas.
3. The research summary shall be submitted in MS Word file/format not exceeding 25 pages; 1.5 spacing; in an A4-sized paper; using Times New Roman; and font size of 11, observing the attached template.
4. Researches that will qualify for presentation, shall present the study orally. The authors shall prepare a PowerPoint slide deck presentation which shall include the Background and Rationale; Research Questions; Methodology and Research Design; Summary of Results; Reflections, Conclusion, and Recommendations; and the Works Cited. The oral presentation shall not exceed 10 minutes. Another 10 minutes shall be allotted for the question and answer portion by the panel of judges for each presenter.
5. Authors shall submit the soft copy of the research summary observing the prescribed format by uploading it through [bit.ly/3AJpW8P](https://bit.ly/3AJpW8P) under the corresponding folders not later than **September 9, 2022**. Qualified authors shall prepare and submit a PowerPoint slide deck on or before **September 16, 2022**. Submission beyond the stated deadlines shall no longer be considered.
6. The rubrics to be used in rating the research summary are presented as follows:

Criteria	Indicators
Clear Focus (20%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The research topic is clear and is relevant to the theme.</li> <li>○ The body of the paper and its conclusion are clearly related to the topic.</li> <li>○ The methods and design are clear.</li> </ul>
Research (25%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The research design used is appropriate based on the research problem.</li> <li>○ The research question is addressed.</li> <li>○ Extensive data analysis is evident.</li> <li>○ The sources are reliable.</li> <li>○ When appropriate, the paper uses different types of resources such as books, journals, newspapers, interviews, and/or the internet.</li> </ul>

Criteria	Indicators
Reasoning and Organization (25%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The key concepts are defined and presented clearly.</li> <li>○ The paper contains enough information to back up its ideas.</li> <li>○ The parts of the paper are coherent.</li> <li>○ When appropriate, the paper uses related statistics, tables, and/or graphs that are properly labeled.</li> <li>○ The author introduces every quotation and cites its sources properly.</li> </ul>
Documentation (15%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The sources are cited using the APA Style.</li> <li>○ Complete and proper referencing is evident.</li> <li>○ The literature review identifies the gap that has been addressed by the research.</li> </ul>
Writing Mechanics (15%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The paper is free of grammatical errors.</li> <li>○ The paper is free from spelling and typographical errors.</li> <li>○ The sentences are brief but precise and free of unnecessary jargon.</li> </ul>

7. The rubrics that shall be used in selecting the best oral presentation are as follows:

Criteria	Indicators
Slide deck Presentation (50%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The presentation follows the prescribed contents.</li> <li>○ The contents are logically organized.</li> <li>○ The materials used are appropriate.</li> <li>○ The layout, design, and aesthetics used are appropriate.</li> </ul>
Question and Answer (50%)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ The voice quality of the presenter is sufficient.</li> <li>○ The presenter maintains eye contact, good poise, and pleasing delivery.</li> <li>○ The language used is precise.</li> <li>○ The presenter gives a brief, clear, and concise discussion.</li> <li>○ Knowledge and mastery of the subject are evident when answering the questions.</li> </ul>

8. The decision of the judges shall be final and irrevocable. Plaques of Award shall be conferred to the three Best Papers and three Best Presenters. Certificates of Recognition shall be awarded to all presenting authors. Certificates of Participation shall also be conferred to the on-site audience.
