The closure of the said school is through the voluntary withdrawal of permit under Section 43 of DepEd Order No. 88, s. 2010 per communication received from Cornelio M. Sevilla, Chairman Board of Trustees and indorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent of Leyte Division. The said closure is due to financial crisis brought about by the damages caused by Typhoon Odette, Agaton and COVID-19 Pandemic.
2. The Schools Division Superintendent is hereby empowered to facilitate the safekeeping and repository/archive of all the pertinent documents following the guidelines stated in DepEd Order No. 88, s. 2010, Section 54, Custody of Student Records.
