Anchored on the Executive Order (EO) No. 26, s. 2011 and in line with the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 5, series of 2014, Integration of Gulayan sa Paaralan, Solid Waste Management and Tree Planting Under the National Greening Program (NGP), DepEd mandates all public elementary and secondary schools nationwide to implement NGP by establishing vegetable gardens to serve as food basket/main source of commodities to sustain supplementary feeding; and practice of waste management principles by minimization, segregation at source, reduction, recycling, re-using and composting of waste. Also, part of the NGP implementation is the establishing nurseries/seed banks for the propagation of vegetable seedlings, fruit-bearing trees, and small trees or saplings and supporting the tree planting activities in schools and communities.

In the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, where schools face the challenges of education in the new normal, it is important to gather shared challenges to implementing NGP, capture the adaptation strategies, and solicit recommendations from the field counterparts to improve the implementation of NGP.

The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns-Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD), will conduct a self-paced **Data Collection and Feedbacking on the Implementation of the National Greening Program (Phase I)**. Each Regional and Division Youth Formation Coordinator (YFC) is requested to accomplish the google form accessible through <https://bit.ly/PIRNGP3> until **30 September 2022**. The results shall be used for Phase II Activity.

The activity specifically aims to review, assess, and gather accomplishments and address issues from the field offices relative to the implementation of the National
