Republic Act (RA) No. 10679, entitled “An Act Promoting Entrepreneurship and Financial Education Among Filipino Youth,” known as the “Youth Entrepreneurship Act,” declared that the promotion of the sustained development of young Filipinos whose aptitude and skill in the field of finance and entrepreneurship shall be encouraged and honed through education and specialized training programs, and the promotion of youth entrepreneurship and financial literacy program shall be inculcated in all levels of education nationwide. Consistent with Section 5 of RA No. 10533, or the “Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013”, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall ensure that the entrepreneurship and financial literacy programs shall support the K to 12 curriculum.

To fulfill its mandate, the DepEd ensures that entrepreneurship, financial education, and literacy is inculcated in all levels of basic education. Hence, the Technical Working Group (TWG) was created through DepEd Memorandum No. 110, s. 2017 entitled “Technical Working Group on the Financial Literacy Program in Basic Education.” In reference to item 5.b.ii. of this issuance, the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) is tasked to develop teaching guides and other teaching materials for proper instruction of financial literacy.

In line with this, the BLD conducted the development and revision of the prototype lesson exemplars on financial education integration, particularly in *Araling Panlipunan (AP)* and *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP)* Grades 1-6, and *Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan/Technology and Livelihood Education (EPP/TLE)* Grades 4-6.

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For this year, these exemplars will undergo field validation on the following schedule to quality assure the materials, with the following details:
