This office respectfully acknowledges your withdrawal request letter from LiSQuP Scholarship Program which we received on August 10, 2022.

Please be informed that the deadline for withdrawal request from LiSQuP Scholarship Program was March 11, 2022 and per guidelines and records of your engagement, your request for withdrawal has been **disapproved**.

Likewise, we are inviting your attention to the stipulations of the scholarship contract (Enclosure 1, DM 82, s. 2020) to wit,

"Refund in full to DepEd such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental for having attended the program or course, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through the scholars' fault or willful neglect, resignation from the service, transfer to other agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within one's control. For reasons beyond the control of the teacher-participant, the conditions do not apply, provided that all documentary requirements including doctor's certification are met and are acceptable to DepEd."

In addition, it was also discussed in the Orientation that if you would not continue to attend your classes and still pursue your withdrawal, you would have to bear the consequences including your financial obligation to NEAP for the amount paid for your enrolment in the program.
