**REGIONAL TRAINING ON INCLUSIVE PEDAGOGY IN TEACHING MUSIC

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct a two-day on-site **Regional Training on Inclusive Pedagogy in Teaching Music for Key Stage 1 Teachers** on October 13-14, 2022 at NEAP-RELC, DepEd Regional Office VIII, Candahug, Palo, Leyte.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. provide teachers of Key Stage 1 with a concrete understanding of the K to 12 Music Curriculum framework, learning standards, competencies and assessment in terms of its salient features and spiral progression of competencies;
 - b. provide them an in-depth knowledge on the adaptation of inclusive pedagogy in teaching Music for Human Development and Well-Being; and
 - c. familiarize the use of innovative pedagogical approaches specifically the inclusive pedagogy that would fit different kinds of learners' abilities.
