Other details relative to this activity are stipulated in the above-mentioned letter.

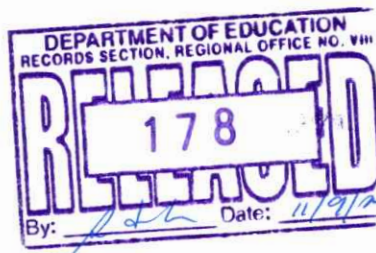

Description

PAGSASANAY SA EDUKASYONG PANGKULTURA or PEP is a prerequisite of NCCA-PCEP to qualify for any of its scholarship programs such as GDCE, GDTA and other Training Certificate courses. PEP is a National Teachers' Training Program on Culture-Based Teaching in the different learning areas. It is a three (3) day Island-Cluster orientation, training, and consultation on the different facets of culture-based education, with a maximum of 100-pax participants per island cluster.

The project seeks to provide a unified culture-based approach to the teaching of Basic Education Curriculum. Strongly aligned with the program objectives of the NCCA Philippine Cultural Education Plan, the seminar-workshop intends to familiarize teachers regarding the nature, purview, methods, approaches and frameworks of culture-based learning and instruction. In addition, it seeks to promote networking among teachers, scholars, and cultural workers so that we can generate productive experiences, best practices, and models of culture-based education in various learning areas.

With the consultative nature of the workshop, we hope to come up with concrete recommendations regarding culture-based instruction in the country, for the consideration of the Department of Education on the following areas:

1. A contextualized Philippine culture-based pedagogy source book.
2. The mainstreaming of local cultural heritage as a wellspring of localized and indigenized teaching resources.
3. The mapping and enhancement of Cultural Learning Competencies.
4. The development of culture-based lessons (Exemplars) & instructional materials.
