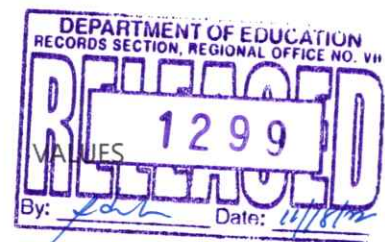
PARTICIPATION TO THE HENERAL TUNA FAN ART CONTEST



In solidarity with the #FilipinoValuesFestival celebration in the month of November, NCCA Filipino Values Program will administer the Heneral Tuna Fan Art Contest, two categories: traditional or digital art. Students and amateur artists aged 13 to 21 are invited to participate in either of the two categories.

The contestant should make sure that the fan art deals with any of the Filipino Values explored in the episodes of the Heneral Tuna animated series, and that the composition includes the character Heneral Tuna.

For traditional entries, participants may use pencil, charcoal, watercolor, acrylic, oil paint or oil pastel on paper, wood, or canvas. Submit a clear, high-resolution scan of the entry with a size of at least 1000x1000.

For digital entries, participants may use digital painting or digital illustration raster or vector, using any free or paid software. Submit a clear high-resolution rendered .jpg or .png file of the entry with a size of at least 2000x2000 pixels.

The deadline for the submission of entries is on November 18, 2022.

Contestants should make sure that their entries are truly original works and that the mediums used are free or proprietary and do not contain materials from other copyrighted works. Winners will be sent information on how to claim prizes.
