TURNOVER OF 4Ps MONITORING

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- Attached is a Memorandum from Epimaco V. Densing, Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, Office of the Secretary, dated October 26, 2022, citing a communication from the Office of the Secretary addressed to Erwin Tulfo, Secretary of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) through Maria Salome P. Navarro, Undersecretary for DSWD with regard to the DepEd's position to lessen the non-teaching workload of the teachers. As such, the teachers are no longer allowed to monitor 4Ps attendance in public schools.
- The Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs) are requested to communicate this to the DSWD Provincial and Municipal Offices and to the Provincial and municipal Local Government Units (LGUs).

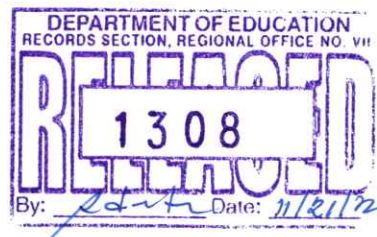



As such, we intend to advise at the soonest possible time our teachers to turn over these tasks to your personnel.

This is in reference to the attached letter of Undersecretary and Chief of Staff Epimaco V. Densing III, this Department, addressed to Hon. Erwin T. Tulfo, Secretary, Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), dated October 20, 2022. The said letter informs the DSWD Secretary that the Department of Education shall no longer allow its teachers to facilitate the monitoring and generation of reports for the 4Ps in their respective schools, pursuant to DepEd's objective of lessening the non-teaching workload of the teachers.
