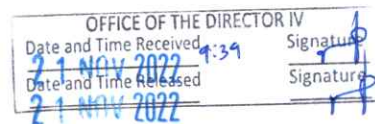

In order to adequately provide relevant and appropriate technical assistance to Madrasah Education Program (MEP) implementers in the Philippines, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID), will conduct the **Capacity Building on Arabic Emergent Reading and Culture Awareness (AERCA) for Madrasah Education Program (MEP) Instructional Leaders** on November 28 - December 2, 2022 in Cebu City.

Specifically, this activity aims for the participants to:

- Enhance their Arabic language proficiency and cultural awareness, pedagogical skills, and instructional supervision competencies;
- Develop an in-depth understanding of Muslim cultures, traditions, practices, and beliefs to foster respect, inclusion, and peaceful co-existence;
- Strengthen their competence on assessment techniques for monitoring and evaluating Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) classes; and

- Regional and Division MEP supervisors/coordinators; and
- School Heads of MEP-implementing schools.
