

DOWNLOADING OF A PORTION OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM PROGRAM SUPPORT FUNDS (ALS-PSF) TO THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES IN SUPPORT TO THE ALS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADE 11 PILOT IMPLEMENTATION

To: Schools Division Superintendents Regional Division Chiefs All Others Concerned

- 1. In support to the regionwide Alternative Learning System Senior High School (ALS-SHS) Grade 11 Program pilot implementation for the School Year 2022-2023 and in consonance with the DepEd Memoranda Numbered OM-OAGA-2022-027 dated February 28, 2022 and OM-BAE-2022-048 dated August 8, 2022 hereto attached, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Finance Division (FD), shall download funds to the thirteen Schools Division Offices through an issuance of a Sub-ARO the amount based on the breakdown contained in the enclosure with the total amount of One Million Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Pesos (Php1,270,000.00) from the 2022 Program Support Fund for the ALS bearing the Sub-ARO Number OSEC-8-22-4199 dated 21 June 2022.
- 2. The above-mentioned funds shall be used to cover the expenses incurred in the reproduction of ALS SHS Learning Support Materials, procurement of the needed Laboratory/Skills Training supplies and materials, printing of Certificates, conduct of Meetings/Orientations and other activities, which may include the traveling expenses of the monitors and concerned school heads, relative to the ALS SHS Grade 11 Pilot Implementation for the School Year 2022-2023.
- 3. The Schools Division Superintendents, through the Chiefs of the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall submit a financial report on the utilization of the downloaded funds not later than March 31, 2023 to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph cc alfredo.cafe@deped.gov.ph.
- 4. Further, there shall be a regional monitoring and technical assistance provision by the fiscal year 2023, through any authorized modality, to check the status of the previous downloaded funds intended for the ALS Program implementation to enhance the absorptive capacity of the Schools Division Offices.

The current Learner Information System (LIS) for the Alternative Learning System (ALS) programs only covers Basic Literacy Program (BLP), Elementary and Junior High School Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Program.

To date, there are two hundred seventy-three (273) implementing schools of ALS Senior High School (ALS SHS) program in select regions which offer different tracks such as General Academic Strand (GAS), Humanities and Social Sciences (HUMMS), Hybrid Curriculum, and Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) with different specializations. The ALS SHS program needs to be included in the list of programs in the Learner Information System (LIS).

Per agreement during the meeting with representative from the Planning Service, for School Year (SY) 2021-2022, school heads of ALS SHS implementing schools shall assign one section for the ALS learners following this convention - ALS SHS Track - Specialization. All ALS SHS learners registered in the old section shall be transferred to the newly created section. This will prevent double counting of learners.

The Regional ALS Focal Persons are directed to coordinate with the school heads of ALS SHS implementing schools and with the Regional and Division Planning Offices to effect this convention.

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) and in partnership with the Asian Development Bank (ADB), developed the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum. In preparation for the nationwide implementation of the newly developed curriculum, the BAE shall conduct the National Orientation of ALS Teachers on the Implementation of the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs)-based Alternative Learning System Senior High School (ALS SHS) Curriculum.

The details of the said orientation are the following:

This activity aims to:

- 1. develop deep understanding, familiarization, and appreciation on the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum among ALS teachers;
- train and equip the ALS Regional Core of Trainers with the skills needed on the delivery and contextualization process of learning competencies in ALS context; and
- 3. conduct demonstration teaching of select teacher-participants as

preparation for the implementation of the Contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum in their respective regions, schools divisions, schools and/or community learning centers.

Particular attention is invited to Attachment No.1 (Letters A-L) for the List of Participants and Attachment No. 2 for the Training Matrix. The listed teacher-participants are required to bring their own laptops and copy of the MELCs of their assigned core or applied subject during the training. The National Core of Trainers listed in Attachment No. 1 (Letter L) shall attend in both clusters and arrive one day before the activity in the venue (September 11 and September 18, respectively).

The participants are also requested to comply with all COVID-19 Alert Level System protocols set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies.

Transportation expenses, board and lodging, other expenses for supplies and materials, and other incidental expenses incurred for this activity shall be charged against the 2022 FLO-ALS Current Fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants were downloaded to the Regional Offices and shall be paid in full upon submission of the travel documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Regional ALS Focal Persons are advised to facilitate the most convenient means on the reimbursement of expenses of the participants for this activity. **Downloading of funds to the respective schools divisions of the participants is highly encouraged**, when deemed necessary and applicable.

In case that the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, **Program Support Fund (PSF) CY 2022 or local funds** shall be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.
