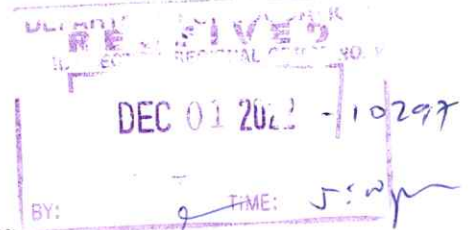

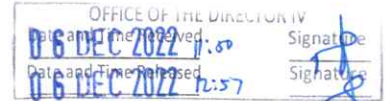

DELIVERY MODE (ADM) ONE-STOP-SHOP SCHOOL

DATE : **11 November 2022**

In support of the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment in ensuring equal access for all learners at risk of dropping out of basic education, the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) shall conduct the Strategic Planning Conference for ADM One-Stop-Shop School on December 12-16, 2022. A separate memorandum shall be issued for its final details.

In line with this, may we request all regions through the Regional Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Focal Person to:

1. Provide the following data and report (School Year 2018-2019 and 2019-2020):
 - a. Number of Enrollment by Modality including Homeschooling and School Initiated Intervention
 - b. Number of ADM Implementing Schools per modality including Homeschooling and School Initiated Intervention
 - c. Number of schools implementing Internet-Based Distance Education Program developed by the Bureau of Secondary Education
 - d. Number of Schools Implementing ADM after Typhoon Paeng
 - e. Number of Schools Implementing ADM after November 2, 2022
 - f. Number of Dropouts from Kindergarten to Senior High School
 - g. Inventory of School-Initiated Intervention
 - h. ADM Implementation Status in the Region through SWOT
 - i. Situation of the ADM Target Learners in the Region.

Formats and templates shall be sent through the Regional ADM Focal Person.

2. Prepare a 15-20 minute Regional ADM Status presentation. Guide questions, format, and templates shall be provided through electronic mail.
3. Send a List of Official Participants composed of the following:
 - a. one (1) CLMD Chief or his/her representative
 - b. one (1) Regional ADM Focal Person/Permanent Alternate
 - c. one (1) Division Education Program Supervisor who has knowledge and experience in ADM implementation



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The official list must be submitted to the Office of the Director of the Bureau of Learning Delivery on or before December 8, 2022.
