The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct a **Workshop on the Development of Functional Education and Literacy Program (FELP) Framework** from February 6 to 10, 2023, in Tagaytay City (*specific venue will be announced in separate issuance*).

This activity aims to:

1. design and develop the initial framework for FELP; and
2. propose inputs for the development of policy relative to the implementation of the developed FELP framework.

In case that the downloaded funds are not sufficient to cover the actual expenses incurred, **Program Support Fund (PSF) FY 2022 or local funds** will be utilized to augment the reimbursement of the said expenses.
