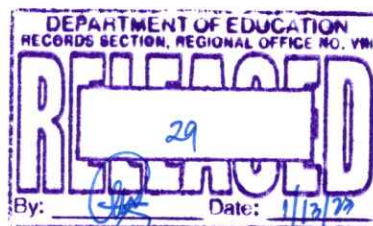

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct a **Workshop on the Development of Academic-Focused Bridging Program (AFBP) Framework** from February 6 to 10, 2023 in Tanza Oasis Hotel and Resort, KM 41 Antero Soriano Highway, Tanza, Cavite.

This activity aims to:

1. design and develop the initial framework for AFBP; and
2. propose inputs for the development of policy relative to the implementation of the developed AFBP framework.
