### SUBMISSION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION (SPED) DATA FOR SY 2022-2023

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Division SPED Coordinators
All Others Concerned

- 1. As part of the Region's efforts to enhance its services through the utilization of accurate data, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), requires the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to accomplish and submit updated data on the Special Education (SPED) Program for S.Y. 2022-2023 on or before February 3, 2023.
- The needed data from the Division shall include the following items:
  - a. Number of enrolled learners with disabilities (LWDs) across grade levels from public and private school who are classified according to type of disability/difficulty based on medical diagnosis or observed manifestation per DepEd Order No. 23, s. 2022 (Enclosures A and B);
  - List and number of public schools implementing the SPED Program (schools with at least one enrolled LWD) in the Division as of January 3, 2023 (Enclosure C);
  - List and number of private schools serving LWDs as of the current school year (Enclosure D);
  - d. List and number of teachers with SPED Teacher Items per implementing school (Enclosure E);
  - e. List of other teachers without SPED Teacher Items who are assigned to teach LWDs in the current school year per implementing school (Enclosure F):
  - f. Number of needed SPED Teacher Items in the Division and list of teachers who are qualified for the said items per DepEd Order No. 7, s. 2015 (Enclosure G);
  - g. Number and types of learning resources that are available for LWDs (Enclosure H);
  - h. List of teachers who are identified as trainers in SPED in the Division (Enclosure I);
  - List of SPED trainings, workshops, and activities conducted in the Division during the last two years (Enclosure J);





- Name of SPED Center or school which has been identified as potential school for conversion into an Inclusive Learning Resource Center (ILRC) per DepEd Order No. 45, s. 2021, except Eastern Samar, Ormoc City, and Southern Leyte Divisions (Enclosure K);
- k. List of active partners and service providers involved in the program (Enclosure L);
- Compiled report of recipient schools and division on the utilization of the 2022 SPED Program Support Fund following DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2021 and Regional Memorandum No. 753, s. 2022 (Enclosure M); and
- m. List of innovations and best practices under the SPED program in the Division (Enclosure N).
- 3. The said data shall be accomplished and recorded in Google Sheets that have been prepared and labeled per Division. Separate links containing these sheets which are found in an attached enclosure shall be assigned to each Division to prevent unintentional alteration of data.
- 4. To ensure the accurate recording of the needed data and to provide technical assistance on how these may be accomplished, a virtual orientation to be attended by the Division SPED Supervisors shall be conducted by the CLMD on the afternoon of January 18, 2023 via Google Meet at https://meet.google.com/jix-athv-qnu.
- 5. The Schools Division Office (SDO) is also advised to involve personnel such as the Division Planning Officer and Division Learning Resources (LR) Supervisor who can help provide or verify data prior to its submission to the Regional Office.
- 6. Once the task is done, a signed copy (signed electronic soft copy or signed scanned copy) of the data sheets shall be submitted thru email at **clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph**.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
