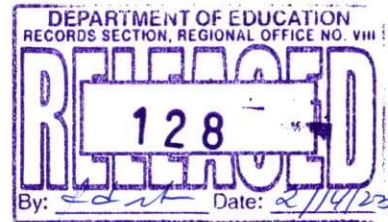

The National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP) is accepting nominees for the Master on National Security Administration (MNSA) Regular Course No. 59 for Academic Year 2023-2024 which will begin on October 3, 2023, and end on September 15, 2024.

The program aims to “develop competencies, values, and skills of key officials and national security leaders in the formulation and implementation of policies related to national, regional, and global security”.

To qualify, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must have a bachelor’s degree.
- Must be holding at least the position of Section Chief with salary grade 24 or its equivalent;
- Must have at least ten (10) years of service in government (for appointed officials);
- Must not be less than 35 years old, but not more than 55 years old upon admission;
- Must be nominated by the Secretary of the Department or the Head of Agency; and
- Must submit the following documents:
 - Recent 2×2 ID picture
 - NDCP Registrar Forms 1-5 (download from <https://www.ndcp.edu.ph/admission/>)
 - Original PSA Birth Certificate;
 - Endorsement letter from respective agencies;

- Original Transcript of Records;
- Certified true copy of Diploma/s;
- Latest Appointment Paper;
- Latest Performance Evaluation Report (1 year);
- Service Record;
- Certificate/s of training/seminars attended;
- Security clearance from J2/PHS;
- Medical Certificate from a military or government hospital;
- Clearances:
 - Non-pending case from respective organizations;
 - Ombudsman;
 - Sandiganbayan;
 - Police;
 - Barangay;
 - NBI;
 - RTC; and
 - CHR

Only those compliant to the above requirements can proceed to MNSA admission test/undergo a series of written and oral examinations. Those who qualify shall be notified by NDCP for further interview, screening and selection by the NDCP Board of Admissions. Expenses of the course will be fully covered by NDCP, except for the costs for board and lodging, thesis writing, and week-long Global Security and Development Studies. In view of this, expenses of three (3) successful applicants who will be selected by NDCP will be shouldered by DepEd through OPDNTP fund, subject to approval and shall be under scholarship contract. The National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP) is pleased to inform you that we are now accepting nominees for the Master in National Security Administration (MNSA) Regular Course No. 59 for Academic Year 2023-2024 which will convene on 03 October 2023 and end on 15 September 2024. It is a one-year full-time government-funded graduate program, conducted through a blended delivery mode of synchronous and asynchronous learning which will include lectures, workshops, thesis writing, as well as local and foreign field studies. Guided by a holistic approach to national security, the NDCP follows a curriculum that integrates the political, economical, socio-cultural, techno-scientific, environmental, and military dimensions of national security. It also includes modules on national security administration, global security and cooperation, and leadership and management.

The MNSA program aims to develop the competencies, values, and skills of key officials and national security leaders in the formulation and implementation of policies related to national, regional, and global security. The students are selected in their capacities as national security leaders with Salary Grade 24 and above or its equivalent. The civilian graduates have the privilege of being commissioned as Lieutenant Colonels or Commanders in the Reserve Force of the Armed Forces of the Philippines.

All expenses for the course will be covered by the College except for the costs to be incurred for board and lodging, thesis writing, and the week-long Global Security and Development Studies. These shall be shouldered by the respective sending agencies of the candidates.

May I invite the Honorable Vice President to submit the names of your qualified candidates along with the duly accomplished application forms by your nominees on or before 17 February 2023. The forms, basic documents, and clearances may be downloaded from the NDCP website at www.ndcp.edu.ph. The MNSA Admission Tests will start on 15-17 March 2023.

ESTIMATED EXPENSES OF LOCAL STUDENTS


The one-year Master in National Security Administration (MNSA) program is a scholarship grant from the Government of the Republic of the Philippines. Tuition and payment of fees for site visits and the National Security and Development Studies (NSDS) are waived. The NSDS is a week-long visit to select areas in the Philippines.

Students are expected to shoulder the cost of local transportation, meals and personal necessities. It is also expected that the sending agencies/institutions/companies cover the full cost of the Global Security and Development Studies (GSDS), including the Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA), research/thesis writing expenses and the accommodation at the NDCP Student Dormitory (recommended for those without residence in Metro Manila). The GSDS is a week-long visit to select focus areas outside the Philippines.
