

The review takes off with the On-boarding and Diagnostic Test phases, proceeds with comprehensive review sessions dealing with LEPT competencies-derived review items in General Education, Professional Education, with navigation on rationalization, breaks out into fields of specializations, caps with the Final Coaching sessions, and concludes the review term with the Send-off Program. 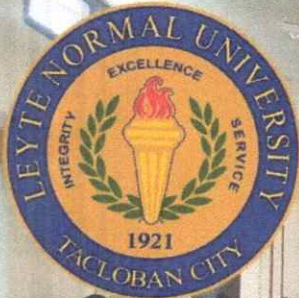
