**FIELD TESTING AND QUALITY ASSURANCE 1 OF THE END OF THE SCHOOL
YEAR COMPREHENSIVE RAPID LITERACY ASSESSMENT - (EoS Y CRLA)**

1. Pursuant to the attached Regional Memorandum No. 1311, s. 2022 on the Development of the End of the School Year Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (EoS Y CRLA), this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in coordination with the United Nations Children's Funds (UNICEF) and Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines (ABC+) Project of the Research Triangle Institute (RTI) International, announces the conduct of the Field Testing and Quality Assurance 1 of the said assessment instrument on March 7, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. via Zoom.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. test the validity of the items included in the EoS Y CRLA;
 - b. gather feedbacks on the use of the Beginning of School Year-BoSY CRLA; and
 - c. discuss other related literacy matters.
3. The participants to the activity are the Regional and Division MTB-MLE Focal Persons and Grade 1 to 3 teachers (1 per grade level) from each of the concerned Schools Division Offices.
4. The Schools Division Superintendents are expected to ascertain that the schools, where the concerned participants are stationed, shall adopt effective measures such as merging of classes or assigning a temporary teacher to ensure that learners still obtain the full benefits of instruction.



5. The link to the activity shall be shared to the concerned Division Focal Persons through the Facebook Messenger.
6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

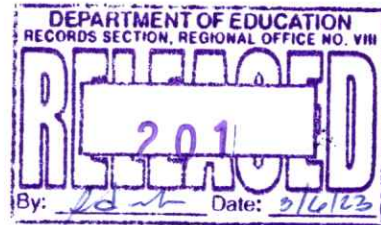

DEVELOPMENT OF END OF SCHOOL YEAR (EoSY) COMPREHENSIVE RAPID LITERACY ASSESSMENT (CRLA) IN WARAY AND INABAKNON

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 Divisions of Biliran, Borongan City, Calbayog City, Catbalogan City
 Eastern Samar, Leyte, Northern Samar, Samar, and Tacloban City
 All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in coordination with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the Advancing in Basic Education in the Philippines (ABC+) Project of the Research Triangle Institute (RTI) International shall conduct the Development of the End of the School (EoSY) Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) in Waray and Inabaknon on November 28 to December 2, 2022 at the Hotel Estrella, Tacloban City.
2. The activity specifically aims to develop the EoSY CRLA which serves as a tool to gather comparative data between beginning and end of the school assessments; thus, further determine whether the learners in Grades 1 to 3 have met the reading readiness for the next grade level.
3. Aside from the representatives from UNICEF and RTI's ABC+ staff, the participants to the activity are the select Regional Personnel, CRLA Development Team and the concerned MTB-MLE Division Coordinators who were involved in the development of the BoSY CRLA. The complete list of the official participants is hereto attached.
4. The participants are informed that accommodation shall start on November 28, 2022, check-in time is at 12:00 p.m. with dinner as the first meal while check-out is on December 2, 2022 at 12:00 p.m. with breakfast as the last meal to be served.
5. The Schools Division Offices are expected to ascertain that the schools where the concerned members of CRLA Development Team are assigned shall adopt effective measures



to ensure that learners still obtain the full benefits of instruction such that classes should be merged or be assigned with a temporary teacher so that no classes are left behind.

6. Expenses incurred in the conduct of the activity particularly the board and lodging of the participants are shouldered by UNICEF while travel expenses, per diem, and other related expenditures are chargeable against Local Funds/School and Division MOOE or other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
