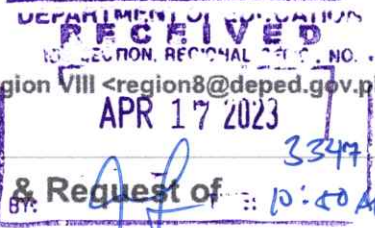

SALIKSEEK 2023 FAQs

GENERAL

When and where is the event?

The event will happen on **06 May 2023 (Saturday)** at **CMC Auditorium and Graduate Studies Department of Plaridel Hall, UP Diliman.**

How much is the registration fee per head?

The fee varies depending on the event mode and registration type. For the registration fee per participating student and teacher, see the table:

*Fee for early bird participants **onsite** is 15% discounted, e.g., ₱350.00 - 15% = ₱297.50

Fee for early bird participants **online is 10% discounted, e.g., ₱250 - 10% = ₱225.00

What are the payment methods?

We only accept **online payments** through BDO, BPI, and GCash. A receipt of registration will be sent to the group representative's email together with the bank details. The participants are required to pay the fee upon registration.

Who is eligible to avail of the early bird promo?

The early bird promo is exclusive to the first 20 participants. The SalikSeek team will inform whether the team is eligible or not through the email of the group representative.

When is the start of and deadline for SalikSeek registration?

The registration period will start on **31 March 2023 (Friday)** until **14 April 2023 (Friday)**. Further details on the registration will be posted on our Facebook page (click [here](#)). Please note that the event has only limited slots, so we will be following the first-come, first-served prioritization.

Can schools opt to attend online mode instead of onsite and vice versa?

Yes. See the following questions to decide further which mode is more convenient for participants, and to be guided accordingly.

Will there be required attire for the participants (e.g., school uniform)?
Wearing a school uniform is **highly encouraged**.

What is the mode of participation for each school?

Schools from NCR are **encouraged** to participate in **onsite set-up**. While **schools outside NCR** are **encouraged** in **onsite set-up**, but still, they may opt to **participate in online set-up**. However, **transportation fees will not be handled by the SalikSeek organizers**.

Can schools send two (2) or more groups to participate in the event?

The schools can only send a **maximum of two (2) groups of four (4) members each** to participate in the event.

Can teachers accompany the students participating in the event? If so, how many teachers can go?

Yes. Two teachers at maximum can accompany their students. Ideally, **one (1) teacher can accompany one (1) group of four (4) students**.

Can Junior High School (e.g., Grade 10) students participate?

Yes. Take note, however, if **Junior High School students are 16 years and below**, they are **required to be accompanied by a teacher**.

Would lunch and/or snacks be provided during the event?

Yes. The **food preference will be asked** in filling out the registration form.

Can the participants go out of the venue during breaks?

Yes. However, participants should be guided by their facilitators and reminded of the program flow. **Note that the event will strictly follow the allotted time for the event**.

SEMINAR PROPER

What is the main topic or lecture for the seminar?

The seminar is divided into three parts: (1) **Lecture**, (2) **Research Paper Presentation**, and (3) **Roundtable Discussion (RTD)**. The lecture is about Research Conceptualization and Plagiarism in Research. The second part is the presentation of popular culture study. Finally, the RTD talks about the emergence of popular culture that leads to participatory culture, and the discussants will also touch on research dissemination.

How many speakers and/or lecturers will be there?

For this year's SalikSeek event, we have one (1) **lecturer** of research conceptualization, **one (1) researcher/presenter** of popular culture studies, and **three (3) discussants** of research dissemination of participatory culture studies.

Will a digital copy of the materials used and a summary of the discussion be given to schools and/or students?

The digital copy of the materials, e.g., presentation decks of the speakers in the lecture and research presentation, will not be used for distribution nor reproduction. The organizers prepared a handbook for students to be distributed/sent on the event day, however, shall also not be used for distribution and reproduction for those who did not register for the event.

WORKSHOP PROPER

Will the workshop be by group? If so, will the groups be composed of students from the same school, or students from different schools be grouped together?

Yes. Only the students coming from the same school will be grouped together.

Can the teachers guide their students during the workshop?

No. The teachers are prohibited to work with the students during the workshop. Once caught, the team will be automatically disqualified from the workshop. The students can only ask questions to the facilitator assigned to their group.

Will there be prizes and/or certificates for the workshop?

Yes. At the end of the event, the participating students and accompanying teachers will receive certificates of participation, and all the winners shall be recognized and awarded with tokens.
