

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) with the support of the United Nations Children's Funds (UNICEF) and the Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines (ABC+), shall conduct the Regional Workshop on the Development of Learning Recovery Curriculum (LRC) on July 17-21, 2023 at the Hotel Rodolfo, Sto. Niño St., Tacloban City.
- 2. The activity aims:
 - a. orient the participants on the elements and implementation of the LRC as per experiences gathered from Region V;
 - b. share effective teaching strategies in literacy and numeracy;
 - develop and enhance lesson maps and corresponding developmentallyappropriate materials; and
 - d. provide information on accurate data analysis of assessment results.
- 3. The participants to this activity are the Regional Literacy and Numeracy Focal Persons, select Division MTB-MLE Coordinators, and representative of teachers from Kindergarten to Grades 3 per attached enclosure.
- 4. The Schools Division Offices are expected to ascertain the participation of the identified participants with the following:
 - a. laptop (each participant) and back-up gadget;
 - b. sample of utilized literacy and numeracy materials;
 - c. curriculum guides (CG-MELCs) and Primer Lessons in soft and hard copies;
 - d. materials for the manipulative resources to complement the supplies to be provided by the sponsoring organization; and
 - assessment results EoSY CRLA Class and School Summary and EGRA data both consolidated and raw data in excel format.
- Expenses on the board and lodging shall be shouldered by the UNICEF while the travel expenses of the field participants to Local/School MOOE Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
