

The Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division, respectfully requests the participation of the SBFP Regional and Schools Division Focal Persons to the Virtual SBFP Milk Supply Mapping to be held on July 28, 2023 from 8:30am to 4:00pm via Microsoft Teams. The activity aims to update the milk supply of the select SDOs who recommended to procure commercial milk due to lack of commitment from partners, or critical areas in the SDO where pasteurized or sterilized milk is difficult to serve, or unliquidated accounts with NDA or PCC. In line with this, may we also respectfully request the SDOs to submit a report/memo stating why the select SDOs recommended the procurement of commercial milk. They may also include the historical context of problems encountered with previously served pasteurized or sterilized milk. It would also be helpful to provide details on the implementation schedule they experienced from the time they released the funds to the completion of milk deliveries, up to the time the final liquidation documents were submitted.
