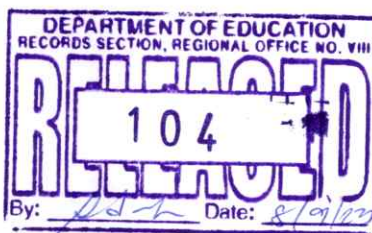

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) and in collaboration with Australia Awards and Alumni Engagement Program-Philippines (AAAEP-P), will conduct a two-day live-out seminar workshop focusing on Science Investigatory Projects (SIPs) for secondary schools in the provinces of Northern Samar, Samar, and Eastern Samar.

2. The activity is part of The Idea Lab (or the Science and Technology Lab for Teachers and Students—Project STILTS), a teaching and learning project funded by the Australian Government. The goal of this project is to develop students and teachers who are functionally literate in science, technology, and the environment. Other activities include a mentoring program using a hybrid model for the conduct of Science Investigatory Projects (SIPs), and the awarding of book and video lesson learning packages. The **live-out training** will be held at these locations and dates:

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3. The participants to this activity are 25 STEM teachers and 25 students (Grades 9–11). The names of participants will be issued in a separate memorandum. The number of slots per Division is as follows:

4. Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds/MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expenses for snacks, lunch, venue, honoraria of resource persons, and training modules and kits will be borne by Australian Global Alumni through its Project Leader, Ms. Janeth Morata-Fuentes, Special Science Teacher V of Philippine Science High School, Eastern Visayas Campus.

5. The participants to this activity who travel or render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays can avail of Service Credits, CTO or COC equivalent to eight (8) hours of service per day, whichever is applicable per DepEd Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.

6. The Regional Focal Persons of this project, Dr. Ryan Tiu of CLMD, and Mr. Michael Parado of HRDD/NEAP R, will monitor the implementation.

7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

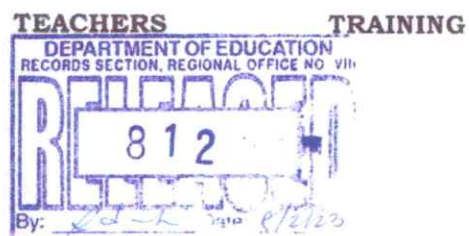

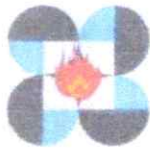

Good day, Ma'am!

I would like to express my sincere appreciation for your invaluable support in allowing collaboration between the Department of Education Region 8 and Project STILTS (**Science and Technology Idea Lab for Teachers and Students**) of the Australian Awards and Alumni Engagement Program-Philippines (AAAEP). I hope that this will enable us to create a powerful learning platform with a lasting impact on everyone involved.

I had a meeting with representatives from the Curriculum and Learning Management and the Human Resource Development Divisions last July 16, 2023 and together, we came up with the following recommendations to move forward with the project:

1. For **Dr. Ryan Tiu and Mr. Michael Parado** from CLMD and HRDD to be focal persons to the project;
2. For DEPED to identify teacher-learner participants based on the criteria set by the Project Team
 - ✓ 25 STEM teachers and 25 learners (possibly Grades 9-11) from each province (a total of 150 participants from the 3 provinces)
 - ✓ STEM teachers should be highly committed and willing to assist with the students' mentoring program (i.e., the development of a Science Investigatory Project) which will be done within 3 months after training.
3. For the 2-day seminar-workshop to be held per province (Samar, Eastern Samar, Northern Samar) and on these locations and dates:
 - ✓ **Catarman, Northern Samar: August 17-18, 2023**
 - ✓ **Catbalogan City, Samar: September 15-16, 2023**
 - ✓ **Borongan City, Eastern Samar: October 13-14, 2023**


4. For the Australian Global Alumni to shoulder these training costs:
 - ✓ AM/PM snacks and lunch for the 2 days of training
 - ✓ Training modules and training kits
 - ✓ Honoraria of resource persons
 - ✓ Venue
5. For DEPED to issue a MEMORANDUM allowing pre-identified teachers and learners to be part of Project STILTS and for them to attend the training on official travel;
6. To request, depending on their availability, for the presence of Dr. Ryan Tiu and Mr. Michael during the training so they can monitor the project's implementation;
7. To request for DEPED and the AAAEGPP to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding/Agreement for this particular project.

I will be in constant contact with Dr. Tiu and Mr. Parado to work out logistics concerns for the project. I will also update your office regarding major outputs during implementation of the activities.

Again, let me express my deepest gratitude to you for making this collaboration possible.
