1. This Office, through the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), announces that the Regional Training of Trainers (RTOT) on Creative Pedagogies in Teaching Literacy, Numeracy, and Social-Emotional Learning (SEL): Instructional Leadership Training (ILT) is changed to "Regional Training of Trainers (RTOT) on Creative Pedagogies in Teaching Literacy and Social-Emotional Learning (SEL): Instructional Leadership Training (ILT)" and shall be held on **September 26 – 29, 2023 (Batch 1)** and **October 3 – 6, 2023 (Batch 2)** at Milka Hotel, Brgy. 2. This training for instructional leaders is a **Continuing Professional Development (CPD) accredited program** by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) – Council for Professional Teachers with 15 CPD credit units.

4. This training program aims to (a) capacitate the participants on the content and platform to be used in the Mass Training of School Heads at the Elementary Level; (b) draft research-based and data-driven project initiatives that will improve learning outcomes of the K to 3 learners in the region, Schools Divisions, and schools/learning centers; and (c) form linkages and share with other Schools Divisions and schools/learning centers noteworthy practices which are aligned with the Instructional Leadership principles.

5. The 13 Schools Division Offices (SDOs), through the Human Resource Development Section, in collaboration with the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall endorse 7, 8, or 9 participants, depending on the SDO's allocation (Enclosure 1). The selection shall strictly follow these criteria:

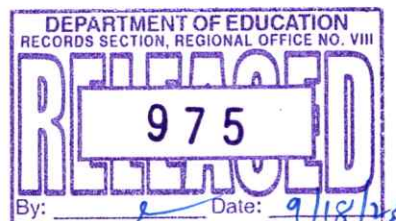
- must be a School Head in the Elementary Level;
- must be a recognized NEAP Learning Facilitator by the Central Office or Regional Office (*preferred*);
- with a strong background in the K to 3 curriculum and school operations;
- with thorough content knowledge and technical background in Early Language and Literacy Development and Early Grade Reading;
- possesses basic computer skills and technical know-how on the use of online platforms (e.g., Zoom, Google Meet, MS Teams, etc.);
- must be a Master's Degree holder (*with specialization in Early Literacy, preferred*); and
- has a good command of the English and Filipino languages.

6. Enclosed are the Schools Division's Allocation List (Enclosure 1), List of Resource Persons (Enclosure 2), RTOT Core Team (Enclosure 3), Program of Activities (Enclosure 4), and the List of Endorsed Participants (Enclosure 5) for reference.

8. Travel expenses of the resource persons shall be charged to HRD PSF or to their MOOE/Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
9. In the exigency of the service in preparation for the RTOT, HRDD personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Overtime Credits (COCs) for the services rendered beyond office hours and during weekends, subject to the existing guidelines.
10. All other provisions stipulated in Regional Memorandum No. 543, s. 2023, which are consistent with this issuance shall remain in force.
11. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

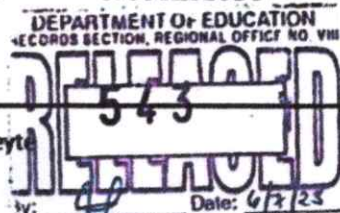
