The Office of the Undersecretary for Operations (OUOPS), through the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS) and the Bureau of Learner Support Services-Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD), transitioning to Learner Formation Division, will conduct a series of Microsoft Youth Ambassadors (MYA) Capstone Projects on September 18 to November 10, 2023 which will be done on a hybrid setting and will be led by the successful MYA 2.0 participants nationwide.

In partnership with Microsoft Philippines, this program aims to onboard empowered Filipino learners who will represent the Department of Education (DepEd) by promoting the innovative and responsible use of technology in the school and the community, provide learners with access to resources and a variety of opportunities to deepen their knowledge and practice their skills while supporting their curricular and co-curricular activities, and promote the importance of creating and maintaining a culture of digital citizenship that extends beyond the classroom and the school.

As part of the program completion, all MYA 2.0 successful applicants are required to conduct their own training to impart basic knowledge on topics like: *Microsoft 365 applications, Cybersecurity, Digital Citizenship, Servant Leadership* and *Professional Communication Skills*. Through this, all MYAs shall be able to communicate effectively with their team members and fellow learners to bring out the best possible outputs in technology.
