Greetings from the Alliance for Improving Health Outcomes!

Adolescent pregnancy is a significant public health issue in the Philippines, with a high prevalence rate compared to other countries in Southeast Asia. One in ten Filipino women aged 15-19 is already a mother, and the country has the highest rate of adolescent pregnancy in the region. Several things contribute to this problem, such as poverty, a lack of access to comprehensive sexual education, and cultural and social norms that support early marriage and childbearing.

As part of the Joint Program of UN Agencies (World Health Organization, United Nations Population Fund, United Nations Children's Fund) and Korea international Cooperation Agency's efforts to reduce adolescent pregnancy in the Philippines, the Alliance for Improving Health Outcomes (AIHO) was engaged to implement the project "Baseline Study for the KOICA funded Joint Program on Accelerating the Reduction of Adelescent Pregnancy in Southern Leyte and Samar in the Philippines. Tunder this project, we will collect baseline data on the indicators that affect adolescent pregnancy and map out the policies and services on adolescent sexual reproductive health in selected municipalities in Samar and Southern Levie.

Part of our study involves the collection of existing data on baseline indicators and policies within the target study sites. In line with this, we would like to respectfully request data on the number of educators trained in Comprehensive Sexual Education (CSE) at our target sites. It would be much appreciated as well if the data were disaggregated by sex, the number of teachers, school heads, and schools that have been oriented on CSE, as well as the total number of teachers and schools in the target municipalities.
