1. 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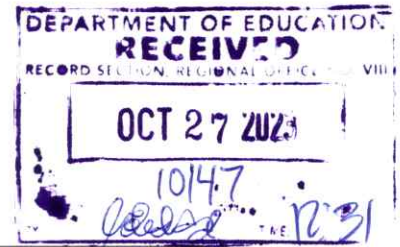


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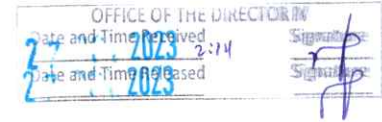

#MabuligAko! Challenge

Official Mechanics

1. The competition is open to bona fide Senior High School students enrolled in a school in Tacloban City.
2. Students will compete in teams composed of three students and one faculty. Each team must select a Captain who will oversee the buzzer and will be the official spokesperson of the team. Only the captain can give the final answer.
3. All teams are required to download the EZBuzzer app that will be used as the buzzer for the competition. Link is provided below.
4. The competition will cover topics along four categories:
 - Economic and Financial Literacy Concepts
 - Socioeconomic Development
 - The Eastern Visayas Regional Development Plan 2023-2028
 - Eastern Visayas Facts and Figures
5. A panel of judges will be present to settle disputes or give subjective scores on challenges, as needed.
6. Teams will compete in three rounds. In each round, the highest-scoring teams will move on to the next round. The lowest-scoring teams will be eliminated.

Elimination Round

7. All teams will compete in the elimination round. This round is composed of eight elimination questions asked by the Game Master (GM).
8. The GM will read the question out loud. They will then count *one, two, three, GO!* The first team to ring the buzzer gets to answer the question.
9. The first eight teams to answer a question correctly moves on to the next round.

Jeopardy!

10. The second round is named Jeopardy! after the American game show. This round is composed of ten questions and challenges. The five highest-scoring teams get to move to the next round.

11. In this round, teams will have the opportunity to choose the point equivalent and topic category for every round. The first team to choose will be determined through *maiba-taya* (i.e., *humpyang*).
12. At the start of the game, the Game Masters (GMs) will explain the mechanics and determine the first team to choose the points and category.
13. A point and category board will be flashed on the screen. The first team will choose both the points and category. The GMs will then flash the question and read it out loud.
14. The GMs will count *one, two, three, GO!* The first team to ring the buzzer gets to answer the question. If they answer correctly, they get the point equivalent. If they answer wrong, other teams will get the opportunity to steal.
15. The team that answers correctly gets to choose the next point-category. If no team answers correctly, the last team to choose the point-category will get to choose again.
16. Teams can play a Double or Nothing card at any point in the game. Each team can only play it once.
17. When a Double or Nothing card is played, the team gets to choose a point-category. They get first dibs to answer the question. If they get it right, they get the double points. If they get it wrong, other teams can steal a double-point question. Only two steals are allowed per question.
18. If the stealing team answers correctly, they get double points. If they haven't played their *Double or Nothing* card yet, they can still do so.
19. A panel of judges will be present to settle disputes or give subjective scores on challenges, as needed.

Do or Die!

20. The final round is called **Do or Die!** Points from the Jeopardy! round will carry over to this round.
21. In this round, a category will first be shown on screen and read by the GMs.
22. Each team will be asked to place an initial wager of their points based on how confident they are that they can answer the question. After all teams have placed their wager, they can then choose to either raise or retain their initial wager.
23. Once all teams have placed their final wagers, the GM will then reveal the question.
24. Each team will write their answers on the provided illustration board. After 30 seconds, teams will reveal their answers.

25. If a team answers correctly, they earn points equivalent to their wager. If they answer wrong, they will lose points equivalent to their wager.
26. The game will end after five questions. The team with the greatest number of points wins. In case of a tie among the three top teams, a tie-breaker challenge will be played.
