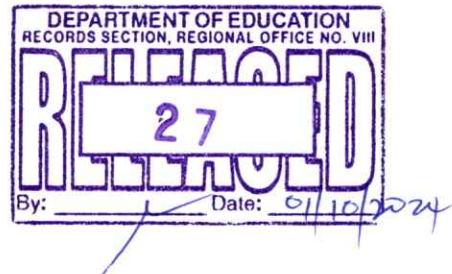

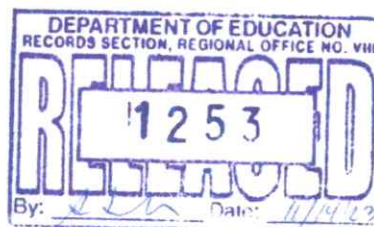

**LIVE-OUT TRAINING ON INSTRUMENTATION AND IMPROVISATION IN
SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS TEACHING AND LEARNING**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
Others Concerned

1. For the continuous improvement of the teaching-learning delivery, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management (CLMD) and in coordination with the Department of Science and Technology - Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) Project Science Teacher Academy for the Regions (STAR), shall conduct a Live-out Training on Instrumentation and Improvisation in Science and Mathematics Teaching and Learning on November 15 - 17, 2023 in Tacloban City, Leyte. The specific venue will be disseminated through a separate issuance.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a) rationalize the importance of instrumentation and improvisation in developing mastery of essential learning competencies in Science and Mathematics;
 - b) design improvised teaching and learning resources using the design thinking process for utilization in the actual classroom teaching and learning; and
 - c) develop teacher's lesson plan and administrator's action plan as an application of learning of the training.
3. The participants are the Regional and Division Education Program Supervisors (EPSs) for Mathematics and Science and selected elementary and secondary teachers. If in the case an identified participant will not be able to attend, the Division EPSs are empowered to identify replacement and must notify the Regional EPS. (See enclosure for the List of Identified Participants).
4. The participants, as part of job-embedded learning, are required to submit a contextualized lesson plan with the improvised material to the Schools Division Office for quality assurance and/or a proposal for Learning Action Cell Session or division training for later implementation.
5. The Schools Division Superintendents must ascertain that classes left by the teacher-participants are taken over by substitute teachers, merged with other classes, or given an alternative instruction or delivery mode so that the learners still avail of the full benefit of classroom instruction.



6. A pre-activity meeting will be conducted on November 14, 2023 to be attended by Sarah S. Cabaluna, Ryan R. Tiu, and the DOST-SEI Project STAR Technical Working Group at the Leyte Normal University, Tacloban City.
7. The expenses relative to the conduct of this activity such as training materials, certificates, and meals (lunch and snacks) shall be provided by the DOST-SEI, while the board and lodging and other travel expenses of the participants shall be charged against local/Division/School MOOE or other related funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
