

Participating teachers shall observe the time-on-task policy based on **DepEd No. 9**, **s. 2005** titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* **to ensure that learning shall not be disrupted and continued for the benefit of the learners.** Additionally, their participation shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024, titled *Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022*, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024) and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities.

The qualified teachers are likewise eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*.

School heads and supervisors are directed to make the necessary arrangements in the schedules of the teachers should they be chosen to participate in any of the training programs. A separate memorandum on the chosen participants shall be issued by this Office.
