Pursuant to the Philippines' international commitment as a member of the ASEAN Schools Sports Council, the Philippines, through the Department of Education (DepEd) will participate in the 13th ASEAN Schools Games (ASG) scheduled from May 31 to June 9, 2023 in Da Nang, Vietnam.

The ASG is an annual sports competition organized under the ASSC and participated in by secondary school students from its ten (10) member-countries. Its aim is to promote ASEAN solidarity in our youth through school sports and provide opportunities for student-athletes to benchmark their sporting talents. ASG also serves as a venue to interact and engage in cultural exchange within ASEAN counterparts.

To ensure the effective selection of the best and finest student-athletes, specifically for athletics and swimming, the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) intends to conduct a **National Try-Out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG** from **April 9-11, 2024**, at PHILSPORTS Ultra Track and Field Oval and Swimming pool, Pasig City.

Participants for athletics shall be billeted at NEAP, Marikina City, while swimming participants shall be housed in the DepEd PASS Dormitory, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.



In observance of and in compliance to DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022 entitled School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023, the concerned schools division offices, through the school heads shall ensure that a substitute teacher will take over the classes in the absence of their respective teaching personnel who will participate to the National Try-Out Invitation to prevent disruption of classes.

Expenses to be incurred for food and accommodation of participants, including travel expenses of technical officials, school sports selection group and members of the working committees shall be charged against the 2023 Physical Fitness and School Sports (PFSS) continuing funds while the traveling expenses of the delegation (regional and division sports officials, student-athletes, coaches/chaperons, etc.) shall be charged against their respective local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



NATIONAL TRY-OUT INVITATION FOR ATHLETICS AND SWIMMING FOR THE 13TH ASEAN SCHOOLS GAMES

GENERAL INFORMATION

I. BACKGROUND

As part of the Philippines's international commitment to the ASEAN School Sports Council (ASSC) being one of its member-countries, the Department of Education (DepEd) shall participate to the 13th ASEAN Schools Games (ASG) scheduled May 31 – June 9, 2024, in Da Nang, Vietnam.

The ASC is an annual sports competition organized under the ASSC and participated in by secondary school students from its ten (10) member-countries. Its aim is to promote ASEAN solidarity in our youth through school sports and provide opportunities for student-athletes to benchmark their sporting talents. ASG also serves as a venue to interact and engage in cultural exchanges within the ASEAN counterparts.

Aside from the Philippines, the participating countries are Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam.

The Philippines shall compete in five (5) sports disciplines in the 13th ASG namely, Athletics (boys/girls), Badminton (boys/girls), Basketball (boys/girls), Pencak Silat (boys/girls), and Swimming (boys/girls).

The DepEd, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD), shall spearhead the constitution of the Philippine delegation particularly the student-athletes who will be competing in the five (5) sports in the 13th ASG.

II. SELECTION OF STUDENT-ATHLETES FOR THE 13TH ASG

To ensure the effective selection of the best and finest student-athletes, specifically for Athletics and Swimming, who shall form part of the Philippine delegation and compete to the 13th ASG, the DepEd, a **National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG** shall be conducted.

The National Try-Out Invitation shall be extended to the best and finest student-athletes in the country who will meet the qualifying standards from the 2019 ASG podium finish results for Athletics and Swimming based on their current record in recent competitions, such as the Palarong Pambansa, Batang Pinoy and other local, national, international, and national sports association (NSA) sanctioned competitions.

A Technical Working Committee (TWC), shall composed of distinguished experts in the field of Athletics and Swimming and select personnel from the BLSS-SSD. They shall formulate guidelines and rules on the conduct of the most appropriate, efficient, and effective manner of identification and selection of the best student-athletes for Athletics and Swimming that will form part of the Philippine delegation.

III. PARTICIPATION

A. STUDENT-ATHLETES

- Participants shall be by invitation only. Participants may comprise of studentathletes who competed in the recently concluded Palarong Pambansa, Batang Pinoy and other local, national, international and national sports association (NSA) sanctioned competitions or those athletes selected, evaluated and assessed by the Selection Team;
- 2. In compliance with the ASSC eligibility requirement, the student-athlete must be 18 years old or younger as of Ist January in the year of the ASG will be conducted. (i.e. players born in 2006 or later will be eligible for the 13th ASG);
- 3. Student-athletes must be a bonafide student enrolled in a public or private school at the time of the competition; and
- 4. Student-athletes must meet the qualifying standards from the 2019 ASG podium finish results for Athletics and Swimming in order to be considered for the National Try-out.

B. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

1. DepEd personnel who will serve in the National Try-out Invitation as technical officials shall come from the National Capital Region (NCR) and shall be selected by the TWC.

C. PLAYING VENUES, SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

1. The tentative playing venue will be at Marikina Sports Center and PHILSPORTS Ultra, Pasig City. Supplies and equipment shall be borrowed from the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), PHILSPORTS Ultra, and Philippine Athletics Track and Field Association (PATAFA).

IV. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

A. Student-Athletes

- 1. Duly accomplished registration form;
- 2. Certificate of enrollment from the school principal the student-athlete/s is/are currently enrolled;

- 3. Medical certificate duly signed by the physician stating that the studentathlete is physically fit to participate. The name of the physician should be clearly be printed with Professional Regulatory Commission (PRC) license number; and
- 4. Parental consent with waiver.

B. Technical Officials

- 1. Approved travel authority duly signed by their respective head of office.
- 2. Medical certificate duly signed by physician that he/she is physically fit to perform its task in the national try-out invitation.

VI. CONFIRMATION OF SELECTION

Student-athletes who have been finally selected to be part of the Philippine delegation to compete in the 13th ASG Athletic and Swimming competitions shall be notified an official communication two (2) weeks after the National Try-out Invitation.

VII. HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

The minimum health standards and safety protocols shall be observed in the conduct of the National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASG and ensure the safety and well-being of all participants, especially the student-athletes.

VIII. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

Funds for the conduct of the National Try-out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming for the 13th ASEAN Schools Games amounting to P 1,538,798.00 shall be charged against the FY 2023 Physical Fitness and School Sports (Continuing fund), subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

NATIONAL TRY-OUT INVITATION FOR ATHLETICS AND SWIMMING FOR THE 13th ASEAN SCHOOLS GAMES (ASG)

GUIDELINES FOR ATHLETICS

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

This event shall be known as the ASG Tryout for Athletics to be conducted by the School Sports Division - BLSS with assistance from the DepEd Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices.

Its main objective is to conduct a track and field competition for high school boys and girls in order to identify and select best athletes that would form part of the Philippine delegation that the Department of Education will be sending to participate in the 13th ASEAN Schools Games on May 31 – June 9, 2024 in Da Nang, Vietnam.

Only those athletes who have been given consideration and have met the qualifying standard shall be invited to participate in this competition.

COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. Sports shall be played in accordance with the current World Athletic international rules and regulations 2024, However, the tournament director may modify, amend, or revise some of the technical rules and regulations for justifiable or compelling reasons.
- 2. Competitors are advised to wear the proper competition attire or its official team uniform.
- 3. Starting height and increment for high jump will be decided at during the coaches technical meeting.
- 4. Competing athletes and designated technical official are only allowed at the competition area.
- 5. Only those student-athletes who have been selected/invited shall be allowed to participate/compete.

ENTRIES:

- 1. Participants may enter three (3) individual events.
- 2. Entries per event are limited to two (2) participants per team.
- 3. Participants will register their school where he/she is currently enrolled as their team.
- 4. All participants will abide by the protocol for competition required by IATF.

PARTICIPATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. As a rule, only those athletes who were invited and/or met the qualifying standard and eligibility requirement (including invitation) established by the Track and Field Selection Group, shall be allowed to join in the ASG Athletics Tryout.
- 2. The Sports Selection Group (SSG) for Athletics primary role is to come up with a list of names of track and field athletes whom upon their assessment and evaluation of the athlete's performances can be a candidate to participate in the said Athletics try out. It shall refer these athletes to the concerned DepEd Regional Delegation for consideration to become a member of its delegation.
- 3. Participating Delegation shall be limited only to those DepEd Regional Offices that have been found to have student-athletes that were invited and/or met the qualifying time.

- 4. DepEd Regional Office may issue the necessary memorandum with regards to the participation to the National Try Out Invitation for Athletics and Swimming or whatever manner it deemed necessary.
- 5. Having finalized its regional delegation composition, the Division Sports Officer shall submit its entries by accomplishing the application e-forms which can be access thru the link bit.ly/asg2024tryoutregform (Microsoft Account Required) on or before March 20, 2024.
- 6. The Schools Division office thru its School Governance and Operation Division or its authorized sports officer shall assist in this endeavor. It shall also assist the coach and the student athletes comply with the documentary requirement as provided in this Memorandum.

NATIONAL TRY-OUT INVITATION FOR ATHLETICS AND SWIMMING FOR THE 13th ASEAN SCHOOLS GAMES (ASG)

GUIDELINES FOR SWIMMING

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

This event shall be known as the ASG Tryout for Swimming to be conducted by the School Sports Division - BLSS with assistance from the DepEd Regional Offices and Schools Division Offices.

Its main objective is to conduct a swimming competition for boys and girls to identify and select the best athletes that would form part of the Philippine delegation that the Department of Education will be sending to participate in the 13th ASEAN Schools Games on May 31- June 9, 2024, in Da Nang, Vietnam.

Only those athletes who have been given consideration and have met the qualifying standard shall be invited to participate in this competition.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. Student-athletes must be officially invited and recommended by the DepEd and Private Schools officials.
- 2. Students-athletes must meet the qualifying entry times in each event or have been considered and invited to participate.
- 3. Student-athletes must only be 18 years of age or younger for the year of the games (i.e., Student-athletes born in 2006 or later will be eligible for the 13th ASG in 2024).
- 4. Must be officially enrolled in the current school year.
- 5. Must be at least Grade 12 and below during the 13th ASG in June 2024.

DATE AND VENUE:

The Competition shall be held at Philsports ULTRA Swimming Pool, Pasig City on April 9 (3:00-6:00 P.M.) and April 10, 2024 (8:30 A.M. onwards).

Registration will be held on April 9, 2024, from 7:30 am to 9:30 am while Coaches and Athletes briefing shall start at 9:30 am at the same venue.

Pass Dorm shall be the official billeting quarters of the Competition.

COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. The rules of the DepEd ASG Swimming Tryout and the Swimming Rules of the World Aquatics (WA) will be applied. Ground rules which have been agreed upon shall be implemented.
- 2. In matters not provided for, decisions shall rest with the Technical and/or the

Organizing Committee.

- 3. The competition will be in Timed Finals Format.
- 4. A Swimmer who qualified for a single event, is allowed to swim an additional 2 events for a maximum of 3 events.
- 5. A swimmer who qualified for 2 events, is allowed to swim 1 additional event for a maximum of 3 events.
- 6. Each swimmer is allowed to swim in as many individual events as they wish provided, they meet the Qualifying Standard provided or were given consideration in each event. An athlete may add additional events provided that their times must be very close to the qualifying standard and times submitted must be verifiable from a 50 M long course swimming competition from the past month and must be approved by the Organizing and Selection Committee.
- 7. Only athletes, coaches, and Delegation Officials with official identification tags will be allowed in areas designated for delegates.

SWIMWEAR:

- 1. No athlete shall be permitted to use or wear any device or swimsuit that may aid His/her speed, buoyancy, or endurance during a competition (such as webbed Gloves, flippers, fins, power bands, or adhesive substances, etc.) Goggles may be worn. No kind of tape on the body is permitted.
- 2. The swimwear (swimsuit, cap, and goggles) of all competitors shall be in good moral taste and suitable for the individual sports disciplines and not to carry any symbol that may be considered offensive.
- 3. All swimsuits shall be non-transparent.
- 4. The competitor must wear a swimsuit in one or two pieces. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knee, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. No additional items, like arm bands or leg bands, shall be regarded as parts of a swimsuit.
- 5. The referee of a competition has the authority to exclude any competitor whose swimwear or body symbols do not comply with this Rule.
- 6. Composition/other items: Men's swimsuits are in one piece. Subject to decency rule and observance of limitation in surface covered, Women's swimsuits may be in one or two pieces. Other items covering the body and not part of the swimsuit are prohibited.

PROTEST:

- 1. Protests are possible if:
 - 1.1. the rules and regulations for the conduct of the competition are not observed.
 - 1.2. if other conditions endanger the competition and/or competitors; or
 - 1.3. it is against the decision of the referee; however, no protest shall be allowed against decisions of fact.

- 2. Protest must be submitted
 - 2.1. To the referee
 - 2.2. In writing
 - 2.3. By the Head of the Delegation or Official Team Coach only
 - 2.4. Within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event

TIMING:

- 1. In the case of an error in the electronic timing systems and/or manual timing systems, the official manual time of a swimmer shall be determined as follows:
 - 1.1. If in the case that the time of the first swimmer is higher than the time of the second swimmer, the average time of swimmers involved shall be the official time of both swimmers.
 - 1.2. Official placing will be decided by the referee based on facts and a referee's decision (RD) will be indicated in the official results.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES:

- 1. All entries must be on official entry forms.
- 2. Submission of entries must indicate the latest best time of each swimmer in each

- event for seeding purposes and lane assignments.
- 3. Entry times submitted must be verifiable and must have been achieved in the Swimming competition being considered by the Swimming Committee. (e.g., National Swimming Competition, etc.)
- 4. Entries must be submitted on or before March 27, 2024, Wednesday at noon, properly filled up and signed.
- 5. Entries may be submitted by email to Danilo Anore dannyanore@gmail.com / 09293264526
- 6. No late entries will be accepted.
- 7. The number of participants per Regional Representation is based on the number of qualified/invited Student-athletes.

Selection for qualifiers will be based on the top two (2) best times in each event and have achieved the Qualifying Times (QT). If a tie exists in the Overall Ranking of selected qualifiers due to the limited number of participants in every country in the 13th ASG, breaking of the tie will be based on the following:

- 1. most number of individuals first place.
- 2. most number of individuals second place.
- 3. if a tie still exists, the individual third place.
- 4. if a tie still exists, the next highest individual placing.

PARTICIPATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. As a rule, only those athletes who were invited (considered) and/or met the qualifying standard and eligibility requirement established by the Swimming Selection Group, shall be allowed to join in the ASG Swimming Tryout.
- 2. The Sports Selection Group (SSG) for Swimming primary role is to come up with a list of names of swimming athletes who upon their assessment and evaluation of the athlete's performance can be a candidate to participate in the said Swimming tryout. It shall refer these athletes to the concerned DepEd Regional Delegation for consideration to become a member of its delegation.
- 3. DepEd Regional Office may contact the Head of the SSG for Swimming Mr. Gavino T. Roxas Jr. (09159669005) for further information and queries.
- 4. Participating Delegation shall be limited only to those DepEd Regional Offices that have been found to have student-athletes that were invited and/or met the qualifying time.
- 5. DepEd Regional Office may issue the necessary memorandum with regards to the guidelines on the conduct of the selection process, swimming tryout or competition, or in whatever manner it deemed necessary.
- 6. Having finalized its regional delegation composition, the Division Sports Officer shall submit its entries by completing the application e-forms which can be accessed through the provided link or before March 27, 2024.

The Schools Division office through its School Governance and Operation Division or its authorized sports officer shall assist in this endeavor. It shall also assist the coach and the student-athletes comply with the documentary requirement as provided in this Memorandum.
