Considering that this is an Advisory, Schools Division Superintendents are given the discretion to act on this matter.

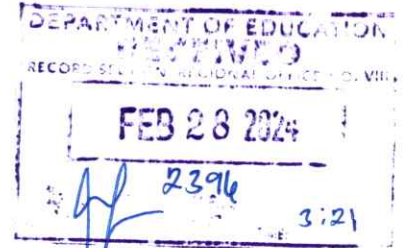

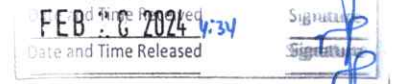



Greetings from the Philippine Population Association (PPA), the sole organization of demographers and population specialists in the country!


