- 1. In consonance with DepEd Memoranda Nos. 022, s. 2023 dated April 19, 2023; DM-CT-2024-025 dated January 23, 2024; and OM-BAE-OD-2024-051 dated February 5, 2024, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby requires all schools divisions to prepare for the Regional Monitoring of the Administration of the Presentation Portfolio Assessment Year 5 (PPA5) for Alternative Learning System Accreditation and Equivalency Elementary and Junior High School Learners for School Year 2023-2024 on the dates specified in Enclosure No. 2.
- 2. A Regional PPA5 Monitoring Team (RPPA5MT), which includes two ALS staff taking charge of the data consolidation, shall be organized to assist the Regional ALS Focal Person in supervising and in giving technical assistance, if necessary, in the administration of the said test at the division level whose composition is found in Enclosure No. 1.
- 3. All SDOs are advised to use the templates found in the attachments of the DepEd Memo No. 022, s. 2023 during the data gathering and report generation which shall be submitted to the RPPA5MT upon their arrival at the designated venues.
- 4. Travel, board and lodging, and other expenses incurred by the RPPA5MT members relative to the onsite monitoring shall be charged against the downloaded ALS Program Support Funds at the Regional Office. Similar expenses incurred by the Division personnel who are involved throughout the assessment schedule shall be charged against their respective downloaded ALS Funds for this purpose, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. All other pertinent details are stipulated in the aforementioned DepEd Memoranda.

- PPA Passers in specialized institutions like the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP) and Bureau of Corrections (BuCor), rehabilitation centers, and similar facilities shall NOT reflect the name of these institutions as CLC in their certificates. Only the CLC Number shall be used in the Portfolio Certificate number.
- SDOs shall observe the timely release/issuance of the certificates as indicated in the timeline.
