EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATION REPORT OF SCHOOL'S APPLICATION

Name of School : RAYMUNDO BOCBCOC DAZA STAND ALONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

School Address : BRGY. CAWAYAN, CATARMAN, NORTHERN SAMAR ESTABLISHMENT OF STAND ALONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

Type of Application : HIGH SCHOOL

FINDINGS:

1. The proposed school has an existing school site with a total land area of 5,000 sq.m. with a Deed of Donation as proof of school site ownership but is still on the process in the Division Office;
2. There is an ongoing construction of two-storey building with six classrooms in the proposed school site;
3. Adjacent to the proposed school site is the two-storey 12 classroom building owned by Hon. Cong. Daza but under a usufructuary contract with the proposed Raymundo Bocboc Daza Stand Alone Senior High School for 50 years with the condition that if the actual school site has already classrooms to accommodate the Senior High School Learners, the Usufructuary Contract shall be void immediately;
4. The school has obtained a certification from the Mines and Geosciences Bureau certifying that the school site is located in Barangay Cawayan, Catarman, Northern Samar;
5. The community of the proposed school was able to provide a temporary fence at the actual school site;
6. The school is conducive to learning, as the site is free from noise, unpleasant odors, and distractions;
7. The school has science and computer laboratories and other facilities such as a faculty room, and admin office;
8. The proposed school has existing seven instructional classrooms;
9. The school site has buildable space that can cater to the expansion of curricular offerings in the future.;

10. The Municipal Local Government Unit pledges its financial assistance to cover all school-related expenses: This includes constructing new school buildings, procuring educational facilities, furniture, instructional materials, and maintenance for at least five years or until funds for these purposes are allocated in the National Budget;
11. The Schools Division Superintendent of Leyte Division commits through a Memorandum of Agreement with the Municipal Local Government Unit to work for the school's funding requirements for Personnel services and Other Operating Expenses; and
12. The Schools Division Superintendent shall ensure the designation of Officer-In-Charge of the school.

RECOMMENDATIONS

In view of the foregoing evaluation and findings, the team respectfully recommends that:

1. The school shall be named **RAYMUNDO BOCBOC DAZA STAND ALONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL** and is authorized to operate effective School Year 2024-2025;
2. The opening of the newly established school shall be on a gradual basis, the Curriculum Grades to be offered upon opening of classes for School Year 2024-2025 shall only be Grade 11. The progression of its expansion for the next grade levels in the senior high school shall depend on the availability of the required resources upon approval of the Schools Division Superintendent.
3. The Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) of Northern Samar Division shall provide teachers trained on the K to 12 Curriculum;
4. The construction of the school building and other structures shall strictly be compliant with the recommendation stipulated in the certification given by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau;
5. The Schools Division Office shall likewise provide school buildings, chairs, textbooks, and other resources to the newly established school; and
6. The School shall be considered in the budget preparation for its eventual inclusion in the immediate succeeding General Appropriation Act (GAA).
