- 1. Attached is a letter from Dr. Yolanda S. Quijano, Chief of Party, Gabay, announcing the conduct of a series of activities in the Divisions of Leyte, Maasin City, and Southern Leyte and requesting the assistance and participation of select supervisors, school heads, teachers, and learners with disabilities in the said activities which will run from April to May 2024.
- 2. The activities include an endline evaluation on the Early Grade Reading Assessment (EGRA) for Deaf Children and Braille Reading Assessment for Blind Learners; monitoring and technical assistance; turnover and orientation of equipment and sensory tools; training for school heads and supervisors on quality indicators of programs serving children with sensorial disabilities; and classroom observations and interviews. Identified enumerators and assessors from other schools divisions and offices are also invited to assist during the conduct of assessment and monitoring.
- 3. To ensure the smooth conduct of the said activities, the concerned schools divisions are requested to provide the needed support to the Gabay personnel and make necessary arrangements involving the participation of students and teachers without sacrificing the classes of those affected.
- 4. Expenses for training, travel, monitoring, and other activities shall be charged to Gabay Funds.
- 5. For details on the activity, schedule, target participants, and others, refer to the attached letter and activity matrix.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

In the Endline Evaluation of Extended Interventions, the Team that will travel from school to school will be composed of non-Gabay Enumerators trained to administer the tools, Consultants, and Gabay staff. Annex 1 outlines the itineraries and the schools to visit per day. For this school activity, we kindly request a quiet area, preferably one conducive room for the test administration where students will be comfortable, with no teachers, parents, or school personnel present during the testing. The classroom observations and interviews will be conducted in the designated room of the teachers to be observed. Gabay will provide snacks/meals as a token of appreciation for each deaf and blind child participating in the test.

In the training for School Heads and Supervisors on Quality Indicators of Programs for Children with Sensorial Disabilities, Gabay will cover the travel, meal, and hotel accommodation expenses for the administrators and supervisors invited. The activity will commence at 1:30 pm for the 1st day (May 15) and end at 12nn on the third day (May 17). Gabay will arrange and cover hotel accommodations at Kuting Reef Resort, Macrohon Southern Leyte, if the participant wishes to stay at the hotel.
