The National Coordinating Body of Clubs for UNESCO in the Philippines (NCBCUP) is delighted to announce the start of the **16th Mitsubishi Asian Children's Enikki Festa 2024 - 2025** in the Philippines, from **July 1 – October 31, 2024**. The target participants are children aged **6 to 12 years old**. This event is designed to provide an opportunity for children worldwide to understand Asian people's daily lives through illustrated diaries under the theme of "My life that I want to share with anyone in Asia".

The Grand Prix winner in the Philippines will be invited to the Award Ceremony and a cultural exchange program to be held in Osaka, Japan in July - August, 2025 (tentative). The airfare for two (2), for the Grand Prix winner and one parent OR Coach will be shouldered by the NCBCUP. In case unexpected events happen, the tour will be canceled at the sole discretion of the Organizers and the possible participants will receive commemorative goods instead.)
