Republic Act 10121 provided the paradigm shift from a reactive disaster response and coordination to a proactive stance in Disaster Risk Reduction and Management, giving birth to Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery Pillar as a thematic area in DRRM with the goal of restoring an improving the facilities, livelihood, living conditions and organization capacities of the affected communities, and reduce disaster risks in accordance with the "build back better" principle.

To ensure an efficient, effective and well-organized Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery, the government strategically deploys Post-Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA) Teams in the affected areas to conduct an aggregate, but detailed assessment of the disaster impacts and identity the critical needs of the affected sector.

Post-Disaster Needs Assessment (PDNA) is defined as a multi-sectoral and multidisciplinary structured approach for assessing disaster impacts and prioritizing recovery and reconstruction needs. PDNA is led and undertaken by the government in collaboration with international development partners and even the private sectors.

In this connection, the undersigned respectfully requests the availability of at least three (3) duly designated representatives from your agency to take part in the PDNA Training to be conducted on 17-21 June 2024 at Haiyan Hotel and Resorts, Tanauan, Leyte.

The participants must:

- Have extensive knowledge and experience in the field of DRRM;
- Preferably for agencies involved in disaster rehabilitation and recovery;
- Be available to be deployed in disaster-affected areas to conduct PDNA for long durations
