REGIONAL MEMORANDUM

MONITORING ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DEPED ORDER NO. 54 S. 2022 - GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION OF SHS TVL SPECIALIZATIONS

To: Schools Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct a Monitoring on the Implementation of DepEd Order No. 54 s. 2022 Guidelines on the Selection of Senior High School Technical Vocational Livelihood (SHS-TVL) Specializations in June August 2024.
- 2. The activity aims to:
 - a. ensure that public and private Senior High Schools offering TVL track properly followed the guidelines in choosing TVL specializations;
 - b. gather reports from the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) on the implementation of DO54 s. 2022 (RM No. 121, s. 2024); and
 - c. finalize SHS TVL specializations for School Year 2025 2026.

- 4. The Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) of the SDO through the Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) / Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Education Program Supervisor, shall ensure that ocular inspection and verification of all documents have been done prior to the regional monitoring and inspection.
- 5. The SDOs shall convene all Schools Heads implementing SHS TVL in one venue for fast and convenient data validation. Please see attached enclosure.



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- An orientation meeting shall be scheduled on June 19, 2024, 10:00 a.m. via Microsoft Teams, to discuss the process of monitoring and inspection.
- All expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this monitoring activity shall be charged against the downloaded funds per OSEC-8-23-6409 and OSEC-8-23-4953, and Local Funds or other eligible source/s of funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
