The target participants are teachers and school leaders from both public and private schools.

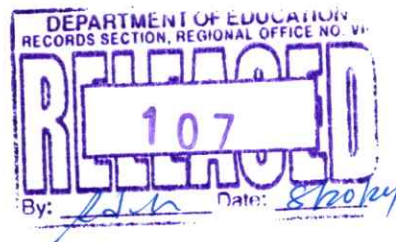

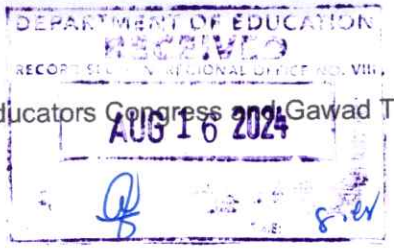



Thank you for your attention and support. We look forward to your favorable response and to the active participation of our educators in this important event.

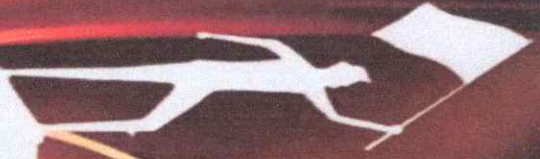
