The activity aims to equip participants with the knowledge and skills to effectively engage with the ASEAN community by examining ASEAN countries' - political, economic and socio-cultural competence.

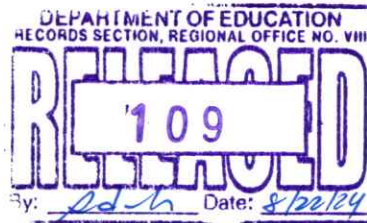

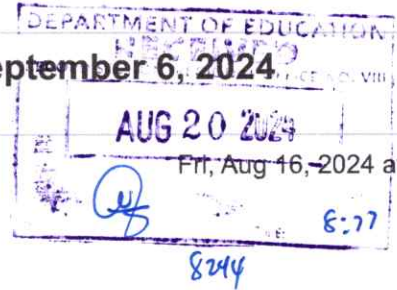
