61ST FISH CONSERVATION WEEK CELEBRATION POSTER-MAKING COMPETITION MECHANICS

Tacloban City, Leyte September 16, 2024

- The Poster Making Contest is open to all elementary learners, and Out-of-school youth (aged 6-12 years old) in Eastern Visayas. To enter, contestants must first go through a screening process where each school can nominate one (1) to two (2) representatives.
- 2. During the screening, nominees must submit at least one online or real copy of sample artwork in any medium (such as canvas, illustration board, or bond paper) along with a recommendation letter from the school head. This submission should be sent to any Provincial Fisheries Office (PFO), regional office of BFAR at MRGP Building, Marasbaras, Tacloban City, or to the DepEd School Division Office by 1st week of September 2024. Participants who wish to submit their sample artworks online may send them to bfar8fishcon@gmail.com. A panel of judges appointed by BFAR will evaluate these submissions, and 13 contestants will be selected for the final round.
- 3. In the final round, held on **September 16, 2024**, at Robinsons Mall Marasbaras, the 13 selected contestants will create and submit one poster within a 3–4-hour time limit. Both the contestant and their coach must ensure the originality and authenticity of the artwork.
- 4. BFAR will provide canvas boards for the final competition, but participants must bring their own art materials.
- The theme of the poster-making contest, related to Fisheries Conservation, will be announced during the competition. Posters must reflect, interpret, and emphasize this theme.
- 6. All posters created during the competition will become the property of BFAR 8.
- Previous Grand winners of the same competition conducted by BFAR are not eligible to participate.
- 8. Judging will be based on the following criteria: Creativity and Presentation (50%), Originality (20%), Relevance to the Theme (25%), and Brief Introduction of the Piece (5%). The total score will be out of 100%.


