1. For the continuous improvement of the Science teaching-learning delivery, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management (CLMD) in partnership with Tinker House Inc., will conduct the pilot sessions for the Tinker Tour: A STEAM Schools Roadshow to the following schools and respective schedule:

2. The activity aims to conduct a series of pilot sessions in preparation for the full run of the tour, which includes the following activities:

- a) Funbot Factory which will engage learners in hands-on robotics and coding challenges;
- b) Fizz Factory which is a lively session exploring the wonders of chemistry through exciting experiments; and
- c) Reef Shack which is an interactive activity focusing on environmental science and coral reef conservation.

3. The identified schools shall select one class in either Grade 4, 5, or 6 who will participate in the activity. To ensure no disruption of classes, the activity will be conducted after the regular class schedule or during either Science or Mathematics periods.

4. The Schools Division Offices, through the Education Program Supervisors in Science and Mathematics, will co-facilitate and monitor the conduct of this activity, as well as coordinate with the heads of the identified schools for the pre-registration, class arrangement and scheduling, and other requirements.

5. The expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be provided by the TinkerHouse Inc., while the travel expenses of the DepEd facilitators/monitors shall be charged against local fund, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

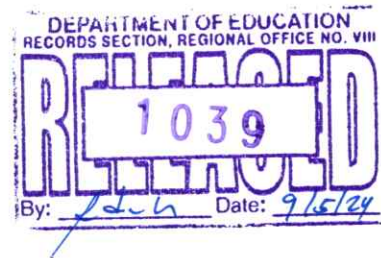
