

- 1. The Department of Education through the Bureau of Curriculum Development-Special Curricular Program Division (SCPD) implements the Special Curricular Programs (SCPs) such as Special Program in the Arts (SPA), Special Program in Sports (SPS), Special Program in Journalism (SPJ), Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL), Special Program in Technical Vocational Education (SPTVE) and Special Program in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (SPSTEM) as mandated by RA 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013.
- 2. These programs have varying years of implementation, but some important standards and processes have yet to be established. This leads to lack of information and sub-optimal implementation of these programs, which utilize substantial public resources. SCPD shall establish the necessary mechanisms to ensure proper planning, implementation, and monitoring and evaluation of SCPs.
- 3. The SCP Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) will provide the department with a platform to manage policies and programs for SCP learners efficiently, sustainably, and effectively.
- 4. The activity aims to:
 - a. Discuss the DO 29, s. 2022, Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework;
 - b. Review all the Special Curricular Programs' data elements;
 - c. Finalize the specific Special Curricular Programs' Theory of Change; and
 - d. Draft SCPs Monitoring and Evaluation tools.


