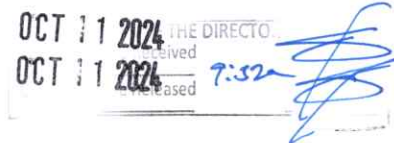

In 2013, the Department of Education implemented the K to12 Program under the Enhanced Basic Education Act (RA 10533), designed to streamline and standardize the basic education system. This reform aims to prepare Filipino learners for the challenges of the 21st century by making education more responsive, globally competitive, and relevant. The Senior High School (SHS) is a critical component of this program and it is specifically designed to improve graduates' employability through Technical-Vocational programs, entrepreneurship, and college readiness.

With the goal of providing a comprehensive, quality, and complete basic education curriculum, the Curriculum and Teaching Strand through the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) will conduct a series of **Workshop on the Revision of Senior High School Curriculum: Applied Subjects**.
