1. **REGIONAL ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODES (ADM) IMPLEMENTERS
INTERFACING-CUM-PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in coordination with the Schools Division of Leyte as the host and in its continued implementation of Project *Padayon*, shall conduct the Regional ADM Implementers Interfacing-cum-Program Implementation Review on November 19 – 22, 2024. The specific venue will be announced on a later issuance.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a) gain insights on how the ADM is implemented in the Schools Division Offices and schools;
 - b) reflect of how the ADM contributes to the quality, inclusive, relevant, and liberating education for all types of learners under emergencies and other difficult circumstances;
 - c) elicit the highlight, initiatives, and challenges encountered by the schools in the implementation of the ADM in preparation for crafting the division ADM strategic plan; and
 - d) provide technical assistance to the schools in the implementation of the ADM.
3. The participants are the CLMD and Curriculum Implementation Division Chiefs, Regional and Division ADM Coordinators and Alternate Focal Persons, CLMD personnel, and Quality Assurance Division representative. There shall be a total of 42 participants with 3 participants from Regional Office and 3 from each Schools Division.
4. The participants are advised to bring their ADM implementation review report in the division, which is a consolidated report from the school levels.
5. Attached are the activity matrix and mechanics for reference.
6. The board and lodging, activity kits and activity materials, supplies and other activity-related expenses shall be charged to the ADM Program Support Fund (PSF) per SARO No. OSEC-8-24-1000, for which an amount of Two Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Pesos (Php 252,000.00) shall be downloaded to SDO Leyte to cover such,

while the travel and incidental expenses of the participants to their respective local funds, ADM PSF, or other sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

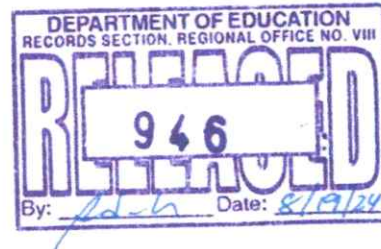
